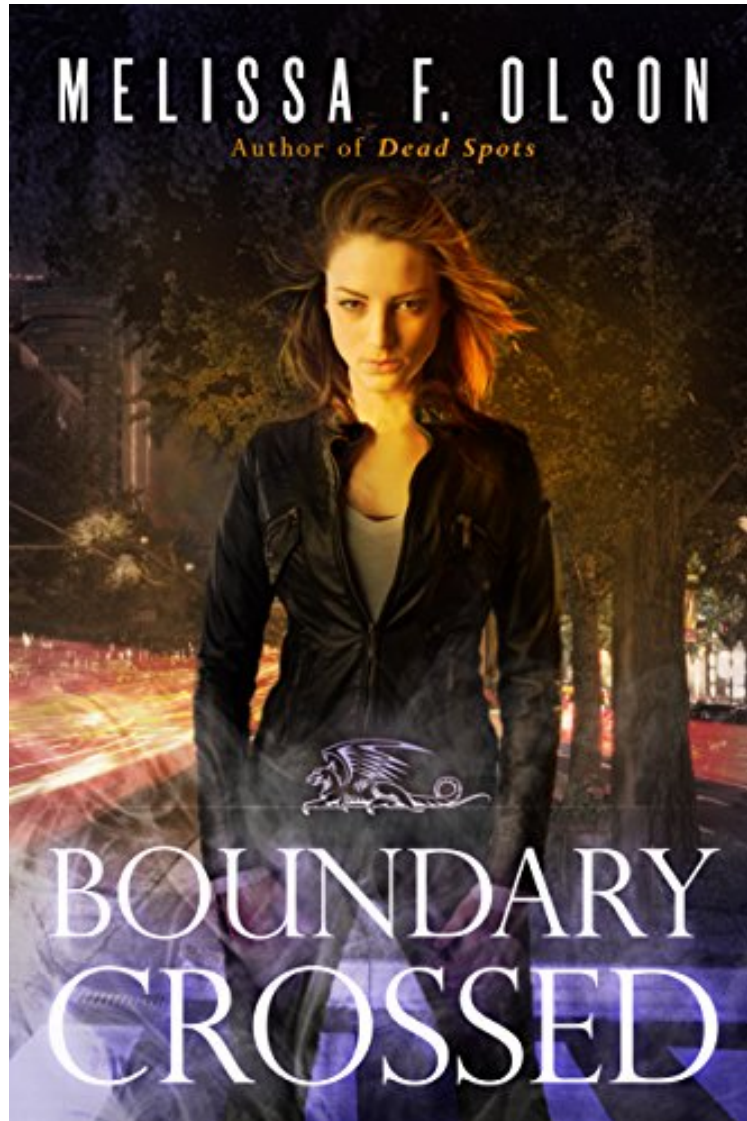

Von Mina This is the story of 30-year old army and war veteran Allison 'Lex' Luther. Who came to live in her hometown Boulder, Colorado, after she died [er, yes] during service, somehow got back to life and was honorably discharged afterwards [I guess the army didn't really know what to do with some female Lazarus?]. There she has a huge adopted family and especially takes care of her late twin sister's baby daughter. Her life is pretty uneventful and she kind of likes it that way, until some vampires try to kidnap her niece and Lex gets back into protection-and-combat-mode. It's helpful that after getting killed and again not dying, she discovers that she is a so called boundary witch. That somewhat levels the supernatural playing field. A boundary witch shouldn't exist any more, way too powerful and creepy, but the newfound powers give Lex some leverage when bargaining with the vampires that rule the supernatural side of Colorado. And leverage she needs: she is new to the supernatural world, has no ties to any witch coven [although with time she makes some friends there] and since apparently her niece is a null and a very valuable asset for the various factions. So to keep baby Charlie safe, Lex gives it her best shot at making herself an asset as well to the ruling vampires and finding the culprit behind the attempted kidnapping. The world-building is solid, the supernaturals blend in pretty well in the city of Boulder and I like the inherent logic and the strict, but necessary rules. There is nothing over the top, no deus ex machina and the reader learns the ropes as the protagonist does. So, no info-dump, but enough information to roll with it. The main character Lex is a cool and likable character and I like that she is at the one hand very pragmatic and down-to-earth and that there are still a lot of secrets about her ancestry, her experiences during the war and so on. And not everything is revealed in this installment, which I like, since it keeps the interest up. Interest was my problem with the middle part of the plot. I very much liked the beginning and the end, actually that was awesome, and they were 4 to 5 stars with the heroine, the world, the backstory and so on, but somehow the pacing lacked in the middle. There just isn't much happening and stuff is rather told than experienced and that made me lose interest. But now I'm glad I did hold on, because really, the end was pretty cool and made an interesting set-up for the next book.
