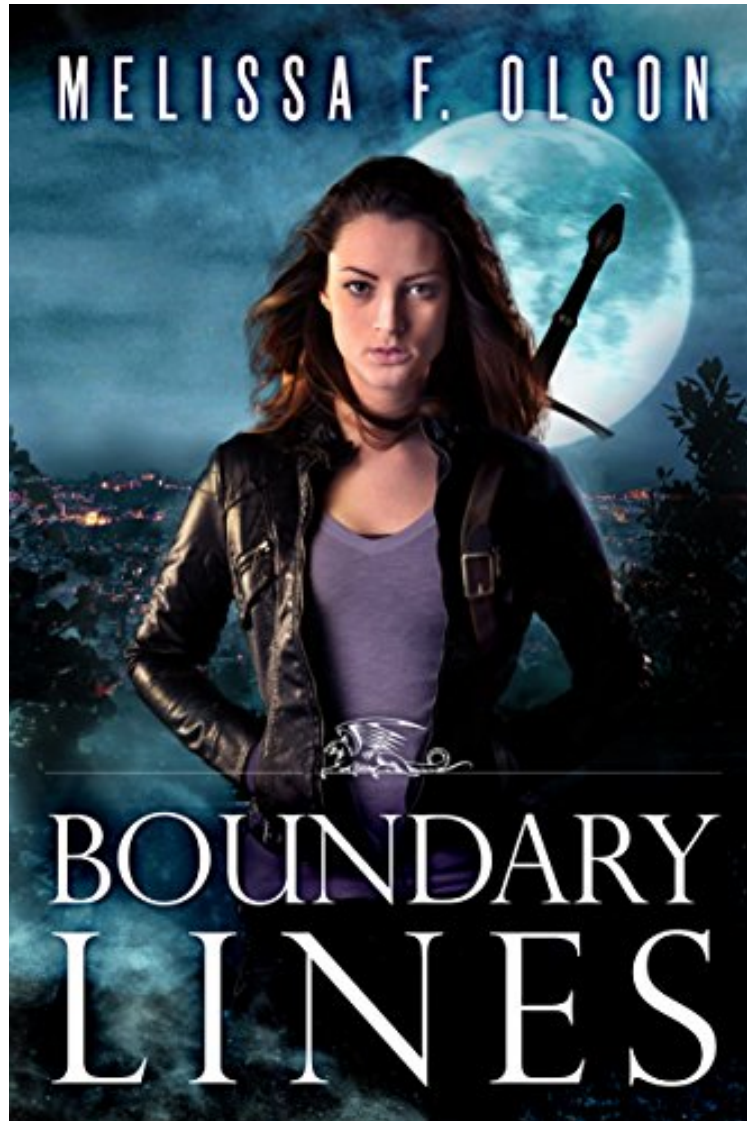

Anyway, there'll be spoilers for events in the first book. And I recommend to read 'Malediction', which would be 1.5 in the series. It provides

interesting background info for 'Boundary Lines'. Review So Lex is back from LA, knowing more about her sister's murder than she ever wanted to and is still working for the vampire head-honcho Maven to keep her baby niece Charlie safe. And things seem kind of 'off' with all things magic: the witches are kind of skittish, werewolves invade Maven's state Colorado [an obvious violation of several treaties: Maven's with the witches and the wolves' with Maven...] and vampires behave oddly and unstable. As Maven's 'daylight fixer', Lex is sent to investigate [well, she does whatever research is possible with Quinn during the night, too] what caused these magic disruptions. And this is the start of a very entertaining and gripping plot: mystery solving, lots of finding puzzle parts that seem unrelated at first, but that somehow have to be put together and revelations about some of Lex's traumatic experiences as a sergeant in Iraq. Other than in 'Boundary Crossed', I had no idea who the culprit was and there's even surprise at the very last chapter. Very cool ' and this time, the pacing is good. No lulls or anything like that, but non-stop investigation and/or action. And after the events in 'Malediction', Lex got lots of points in the coolness-area from me, something that continues here. The only thing that keeps me from giving five stars is the strange 'relationship' Lex has with Quinn. I like how vampires are depicted here, but what makes them special and differentiates them from other UF worlds, are the same things I think of as really creepy [read it and think of me when Lex wakes beside Quinn.... ick!] and I just can't picture it... no, not happening. But as you can see, this is a minor complaint that possibly won't bother other people. I was happy to read that there'll be a third book in the series coming.

Lex hat sich verpflichtet, die Vampirchefin Maven zu unterstützen. Im Gegenzug dafür schützt die mächtige Vampirin die kleine Nichte Charlie. Lex versucht sich mit dem lokalen Hexenclan um die Oberhexe Hazel Pellar anzufreunden, um mehr über ihr Erbe als Boundary-Hexe zu erfahren, obwohl ihr die normalen Hexen feindlich gegenüber stehen. Als Boundary-Hexe hat sie Macht über Leben und Tod, was von ihren Vorgängerinnen oft missbraucht worden ist. Unterstützt in ihren Bemühungen wird sie von ihren Freunden Lily und Simon, Kinder der Oberhexe. Neue Bedrohungen in Gestalt von Werwölfen und einem magischen Wurm tauchen in Boulder auf, was den Frieden der Paranormalen empfindlich stört. Und die Beziehung zwischen Lex und dem jungen Vampir Quinn entwickelt sich weiter. Leider entwickelt sich die Story nicht gross weiter, ausser ein paar Geplänkel und wenig spannenden Kämpfen erfahren wir nicht viel Neues, die Nebencharaktere laufen sehr nebenher. Someone else tries everything to get her in jail and insults her and threatens her, so he IS a danger to the one to be protected too. If she is in jail, she can't protect. Someone offers her to stop the bad one, without violence. Just stop him. No bother, no blood, win win. She says: no. Don't help me. I nearly stopped reading at that point. It just makes no sense. Spoiler ahead! Did I tell you she wants to protect someone? She is told she can learn magic. Which of course would help her do the protecting thingy so much better. She says: no. I am not interested. I have no idea why any author would make his protagonist a silly woman. But this one did. So, if you can't stand silly heroes and want logic, don't read this. On the other hand, I give this four stars instead of three because I read it (and the next book) to the end. So, it seems there is more good than bad in this book, at least for my taste. Still, I always get angry when certain things happen. Like the following: There are rules in this world and many of these rules have death as punishment. And the super villain is responsible for the deaths of many people and tried to do a lot more bad things. But the bad person had connections. So the person gets away instead of being punished. I will at some time read the third book. If that bad person will try to "revenge" itself in the third book and again persons will die because of that person, I will know that the author really has no grasp on reality and just did not want a hundreds of years old intelligent vampire to do the only intelligent thing to a murderer: kill the murderer.
