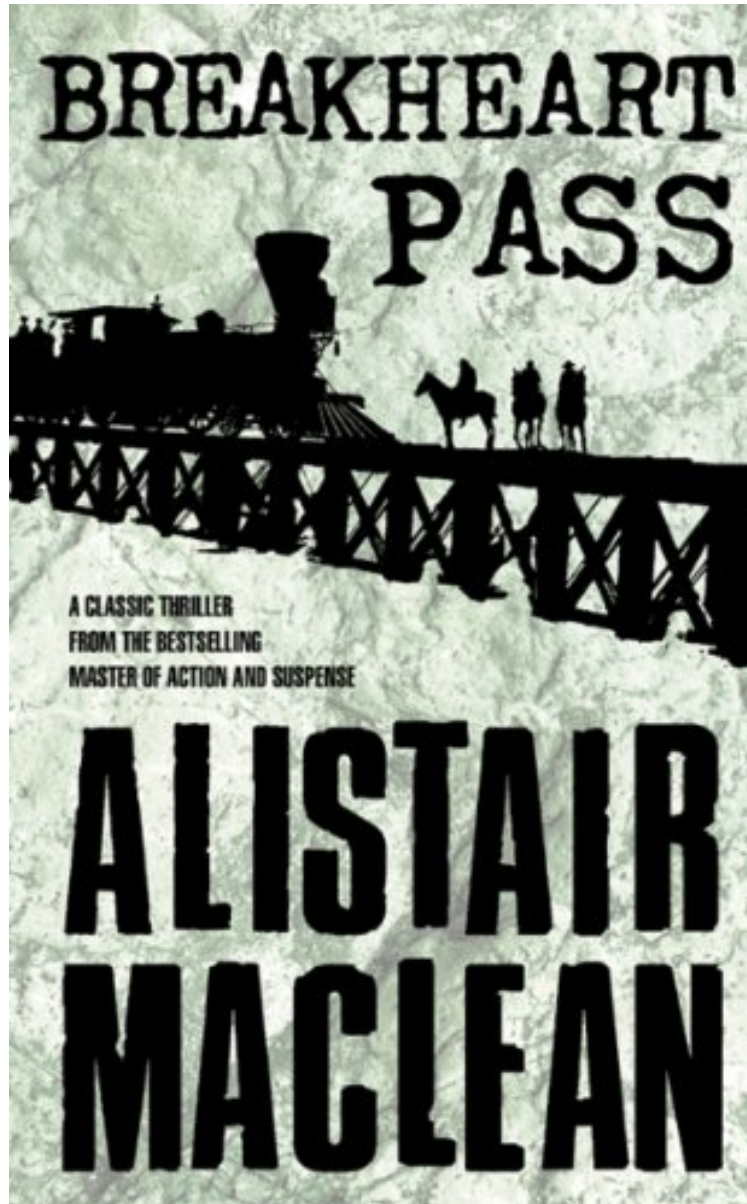

It's that kind of story, with endless action and intrigue, with never a dull moment. Maclean has a great skill for describing hand to hand combat scenes without getting the reader lost - where so many other writers just create a jumble of events that the reader has no idea what is happening... until one dies (usually.) Maclean writes clearly, which is one reason why I love (re)reading his action novels. To begin with it felt as though there were too many characters, but that problem soon sorts itself out, once they train gets into the Rockies. Also, the whole "Indian" cast as renegades doesn't feel right nowadays - so the story suffers at that level. But if you look at the theme of "man's greed", the plot is coherent. One of those single afternoon reads that is pure pleasure, and it is the second time I read this novel, that I recommend for action, adventure and quick-read readers sometimes you just want that short flash of quick-paced mystery and adventure to fill half a day... Only four stars because by comparison to other novels, this one is a little less complex: but no less enjoyable.
