And when he finally reached his epiphany he was as proud as if he just developed the gravity theory. Argh.... But who totally won my heart and made every whining and minging of Claire's worth it. He is extraordinary. The love and forgiveness he has for Claire is nearly superhuman. Having lost his child due to her decision, he still finds nothing but love in his heart for Claire and her situation and not only forgives her but gives her strength and consolation. The things he does for her are absolutely breath-taking. He always puts her needs first and unlike her, without making it obvious. He puts his career at risk, he puts his leg at risk - for Claire and for their relationship. I adored the life out of Chris. The surprise he planned and organized for Claire towards the end of the book made me weep like a little child. Chris is absolutely beautiful - inside and out. So is his mother Jackie.
