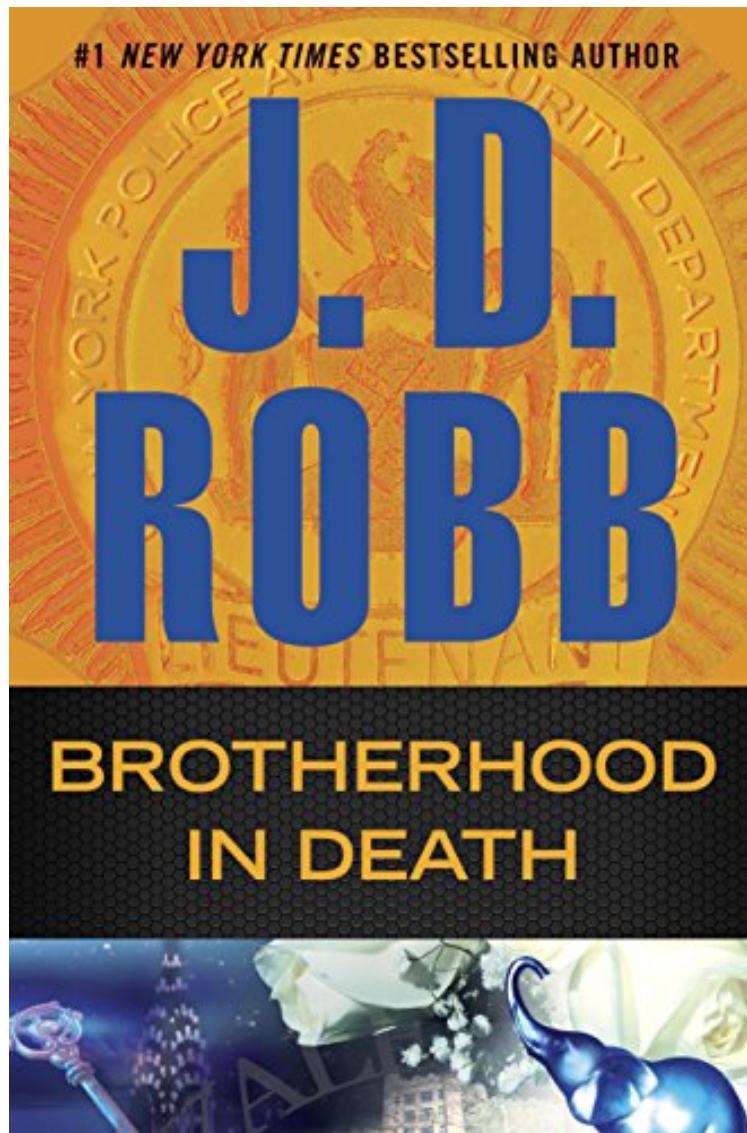

I have to admit I didn't read the last 30 pages or so, because I just couldn't be bothered. And obviously neither could the author. There is so much lazy sloppiness everywhere in this book. First of all, the whole series seems to be

set in the future, which might be an interesting twist, but here it's obviously just a lazy excuse for the author, so she doesn't have to do any research on how real police work is done today. All the "futuristic" gadgets mentioned in the book are hopelessly unimaginative. The characters are all stereotypes. The detective's assistant comes across as a total moron, the husband is a sensitive, sexy, super-rich hunk and the detective Eve Dallas' abrasiveness is probably supposed to make her seem "interesting", "mysterious" or even "complex", but it just doesn't work - she's often just a moody bitch. Because the characters are all so flat, I never really cared about what happened to them. The dilemma of the moral justification of vigilantism might be an interesting topic, but all the book has to say about it are platitudes and truisms. The language is equally full of clichés and cheesy metaphors, the sex scenes are especially cringeworthy. The story is absolutely predictable. There are no unsuspected turns, the author didn't put any effort in working out a plot, which is even a bit original. She seems to think of her readers as slightly mentally retarded because every event in the undercomplex plot is explained ad tedium, nothing is left to the reader's imagination. Why this series is so immensely popular will always remain a mystery to me.
