Average writing and no character development Von Sanya I liked the first two books of the series and had preordered the third one. The crew of the Cumberland is now working hand in hand to survive the delivery of the heartelt "no" to the Krag offer of surrender. There is really very little in terms of a story to be found in the book. It is a sequence of space battles with the established formula of overwhelming enemy forces and clever ideas from Max to save the day. The formula has worked well, so what went wrong here? There is no dialog outside of battles worth reading, the time between engagements is skipped! I perceived no character development and the ships cat gets mentioned more often then half of the crew members known to the reader from prior books. A possible great interaction between a competent but old school captain and Max is handled in 3 pages and then the rest of the story arc is told from the Krag perspective. Not to forgot that the book is extremely short and the writing is just average. I would give it 2 stars on its own and added one more because it was still entertaining in the context of the series. I will not preorder the next one, but might have a look at it after reading a test chapter. If someone enjoys the battles but is not to keen on all the human interaction part inbetween, book 3 might be more enjoyable.
