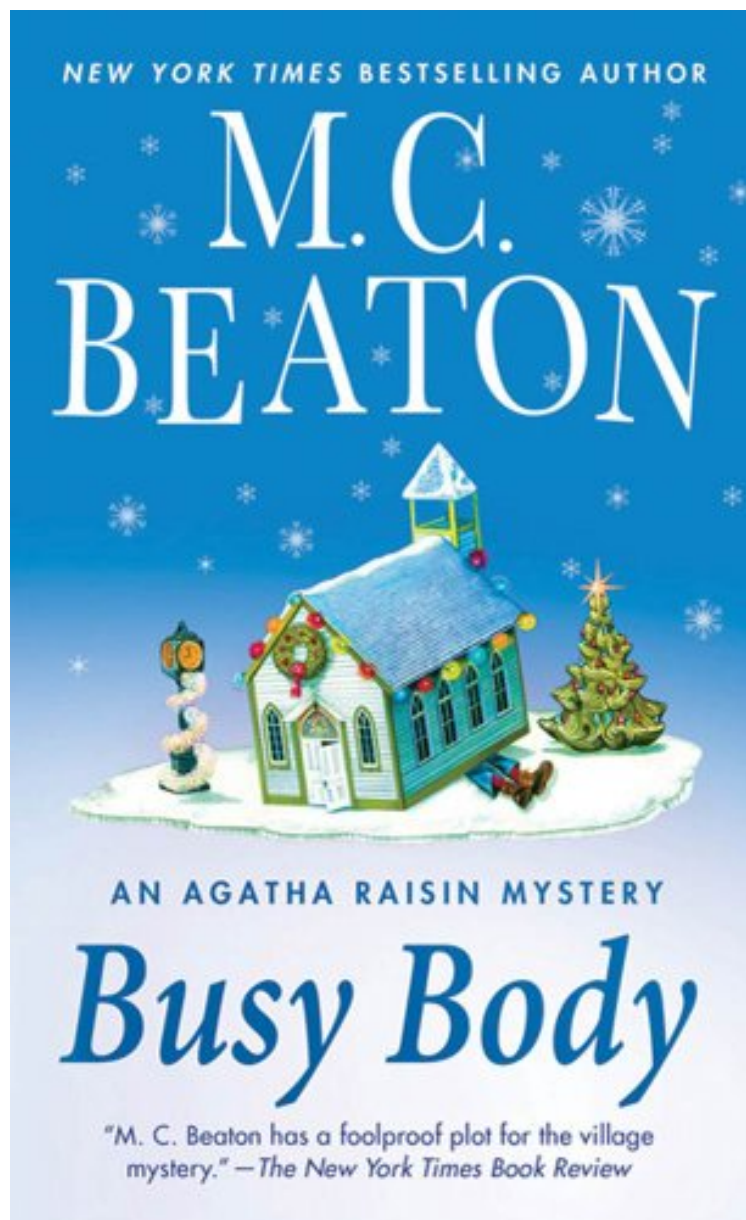

Beaton. While I have been known to complain a bit about earlier Agatha Raisin novels that develop slowly, I certainly didn't intend for the books to be packed with three times as many cases, developments, and characters as could be humorously handled for our relaxed pleasure in an inglenook next to a cozy fire on a chilly night.As a result, the story sometimes feels as though it were written by someone other than M.C. Beaton who was following an M.C. Beaton outline, but without the ability to employ the light touch needed to make such a story charming, gently irritating, and fun, all at the same time.In many ways, the story read more like what Janet Evanovich would write about a frantic Stephanie Plum than the earlier stories in the Agatha Raisin series.
