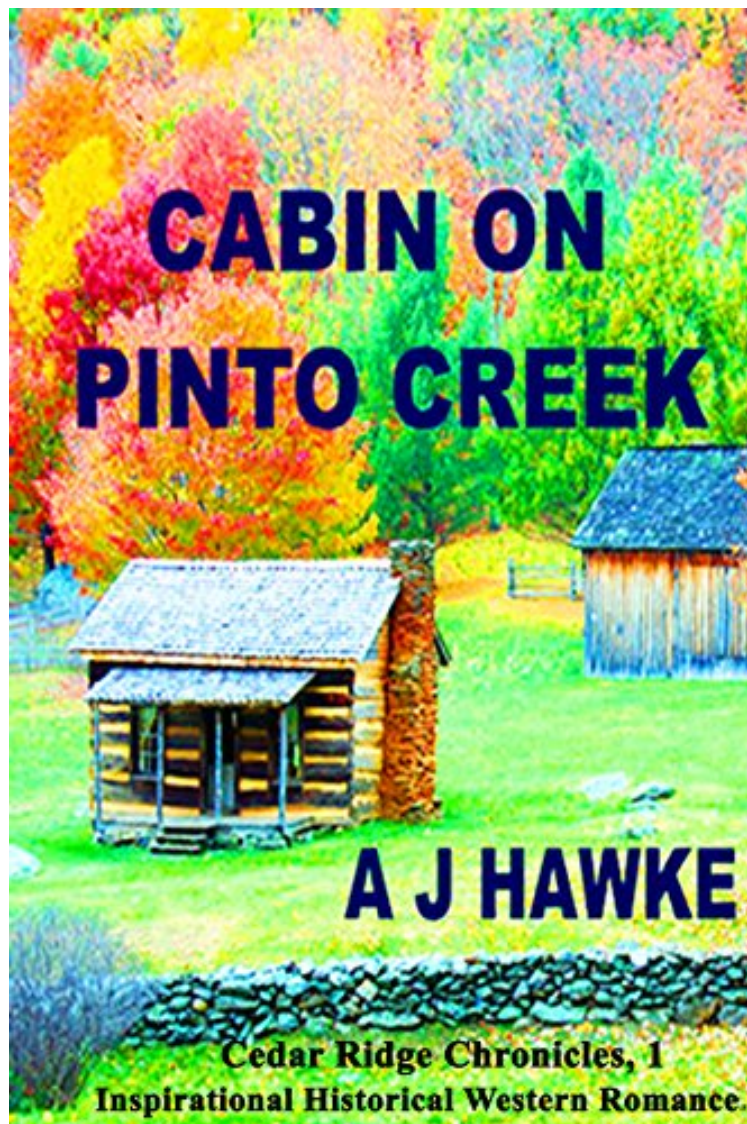

He lost his family as a child and his dreams of his own ranch have literally gone up in dust. He heads for a ranch in Colorado in the hope of finding a hot meal, a bed for the night and most of all a job.The ranch owner and hands prove to be welcoming and he is offered a job looking after a line cabin on the borders of the ranch; not an easy job, but one that will allow him to spread his tasks in line with the physical weaknesses he still suffers after his accident. The post is mainly isolated but he visits the ranch monthly for supplies and gets closer to the `family' of ranch hands each time.He settles in the remote cabin, thankful for the work. While out checking the land one day he comes across a broken wagon and a very sick old man and his young granddaughter. He manages to get them back to the warmth of the cabin and does his best to look after them. The old preacher knows that he is dying and, having seen that Elisha is intrinsically a good man, asks him to marry Susanna and promise to look after her (as a preacher he can perform the service himself).Elisha reluctantly agrees to this unexpected request. He had given up on his dream of a family and his own ranch and feels that he has nothing to offer Susanna - quite apart from the fact that he hardly knows her. Susanna is 16 and panics about the thought of being married to a virtual stranger, but she loves and respects her grandfather and trusts that his dying wish is the best thing for her.The story is rich in its development and descriptive narrative. You can feel the harsh cold of winter and see the beauty of the summer meadow. The love between Elisha and Susanna develops as they face the various and very real dangers of the remote location, which provide plenty of drama and suspense. This is `Christian literature', but it is not a preachy book. There are times when the Bible provides solace and inspiration, but as part of the daily life of the characters rather than any kind of sermon. There is a great appreciation for the beauty of nature and the constancy of good friends.
