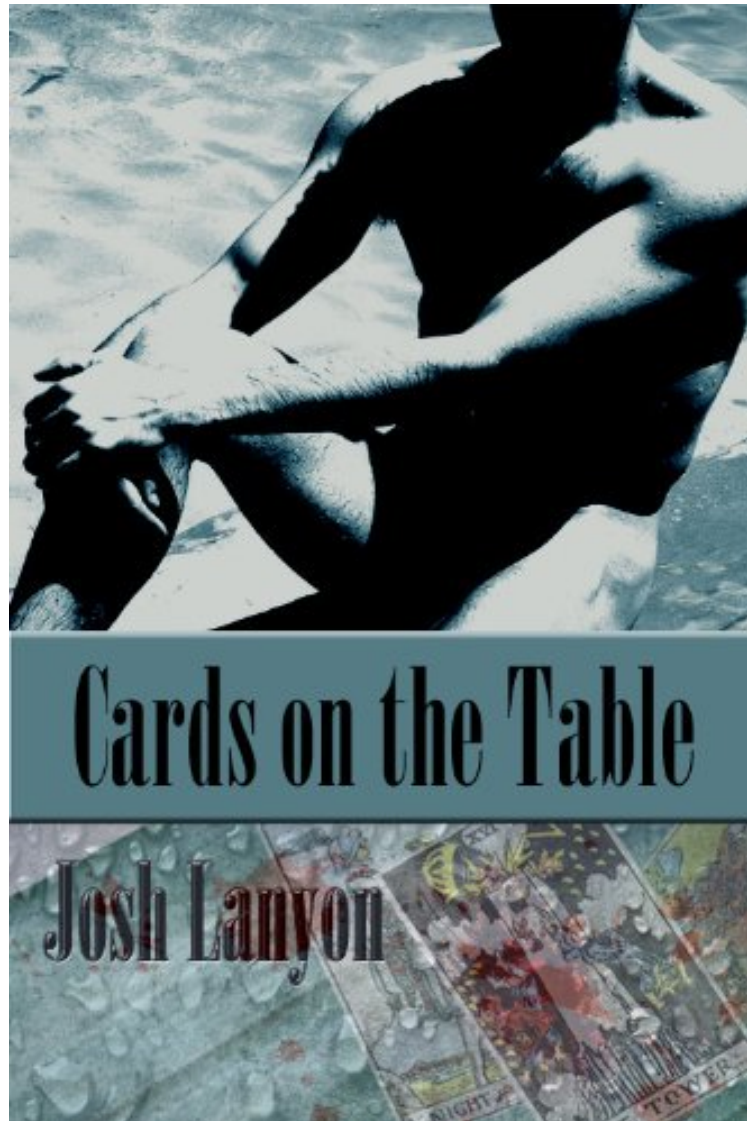

What in particular makes this book better than other Josh Lanyon books is hard to say. From the mood I can maybe best compare it to

books like *Come Unto These Yellow Sands* or (dare I say it) the *Adrien English* books. I just really, really liked Tim, and the relationship between him and Jack is one of my favorites out of the Josh Lanyon Verse. And for all those who haven't read anything from Josh Lanyon before: The crime story is certainly entertaining and very interesting. You can't tell who did it and why, there are a lot of twists and turns. But mostly this book lives from the charming and quirky protagonist and the humorous and snarky writing style that I appreciate very much. To me this is much more a romance than a crime novel and I think that's what it is intended as. Nevertheless the crime is certainly not just the hook for the love story. Also this book features one of my most favorite subjects, two past lovers getting back together. Wissner Ich habe bislang noch keine Geschichte von Josh Lanyon gelesen, die mich enttäuscht hat. Auch dieses Buch gehört dazu. Es ist faszinierend, wie Josh Lanyon in jedem seiner Bücher eine Geschichte erzählt, die sich von den anderen unterscheidet; es gibt keinen recycelten Plot, jeder Charakter, sei die Geschichte noch so kurz, wird zum Leben erweckt durch den herausragenden Schreibstil von Mister Lanyon. Er schreibt nicht über Superhelden, wie es in diesem Genre leider so oft der Fall ist, sondern über Menschen mit Fehlern, Schwächen und Strichen, die trotz aller Widrigkeiten ihren Weg gehen und letztendlich ihr Glück finden. Zur Geschichte selbst: Timothy ist im Begriff, ein Buch über einen lange zurückliegenden Mordfall zu schreiben. Durch seine Recherchen hat er offensichtlich in ein Wespennest gestochen und erhält Tarot-Karten, deren Bedeutung er nicht versteht. Als die Lage zu unübersichtlich wird für seinen Geschmack, wendet er sich an seinen Ex-Lover Jack Brady, einen Cop, der auch sein Nachbar ist. Timothy's Gesundheitszustand, der seiner Meinung nach auch Grund für das Ende seiner Beziehung zu Jack war, ist nicht unbedingt förderlich für seine detektivischen Aktivitäten, aber, wie immer bei Josh Lanyon, auch hier gibt es ein sehr zufriedenstellendes Happy-End.
