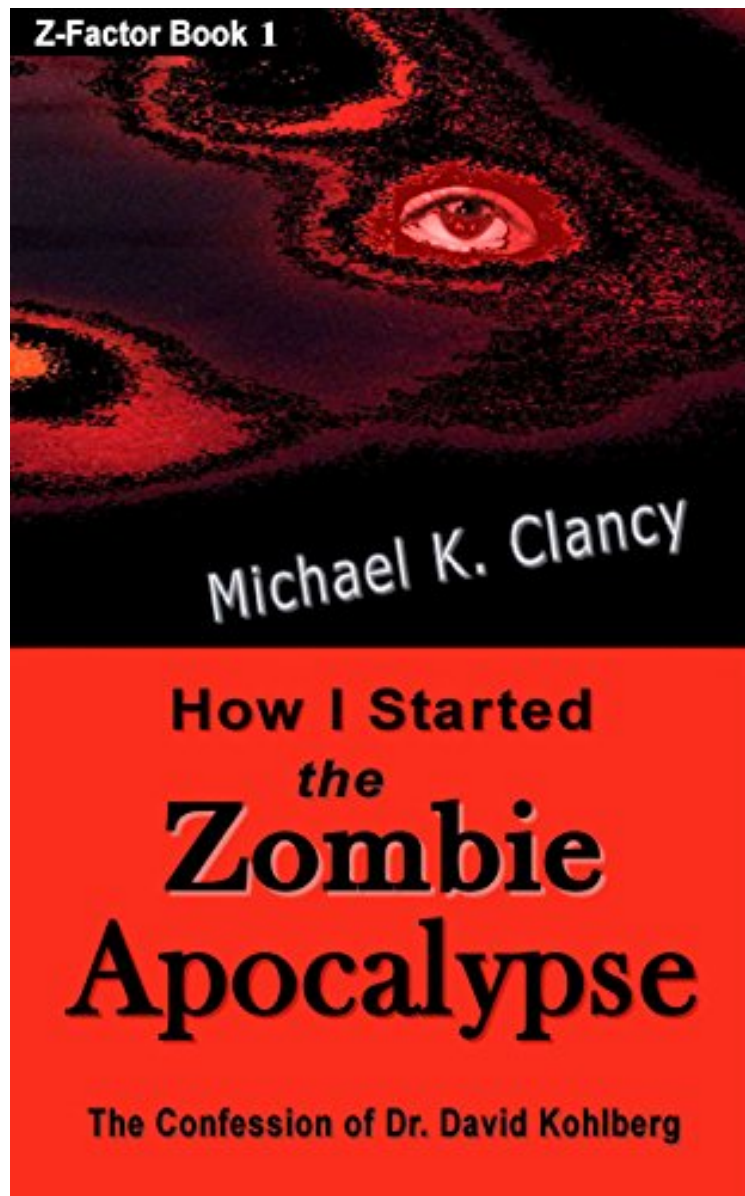

Good story but it does not grab and compress your attentionVon Charles AshbacherWith the current popularity of zombie stories, one more must have something unique and significant about it if it is to be more than just one more zombie story. In this case, it is just one more story based on the zombie plot device. The main character and the author of the confession is a brilliant medical researcher that was a Jew that grew up in Poland before World War II. Hearing of the growing persecution of Jews in Germany and the emerging threat of war, Kohlberg leaves the others behind and moves into the Soviet Union. This makes him safe when Germany invaded Poland and immediately began the first steps in the final solution. Kohlberg continues to engage in his medical research after Germany invades the Soviet Union, although it is conducted on the front lines, so he is occasionally involved in combat. Using ethically dubious tactics, Kohlberg learns a great deal about virus based diseases and he continues his research in Israel after the war. He creates an anti-virus virus that is meant to create an acquired immunity to the Ebola virus and the anti-virus is easily spread in aerosol form. The zombie apocalypse is created by mistakes made in the process of releasing the anti-virus. Some of those mistakes are accidental. If you are a big fan of the zombie stories, you will no doubt love this book. As one that has mixed feelings about them, I found it to be at best average. The writing is not something that will grab and compress your attention, although the story moves quickly and is not dull.
