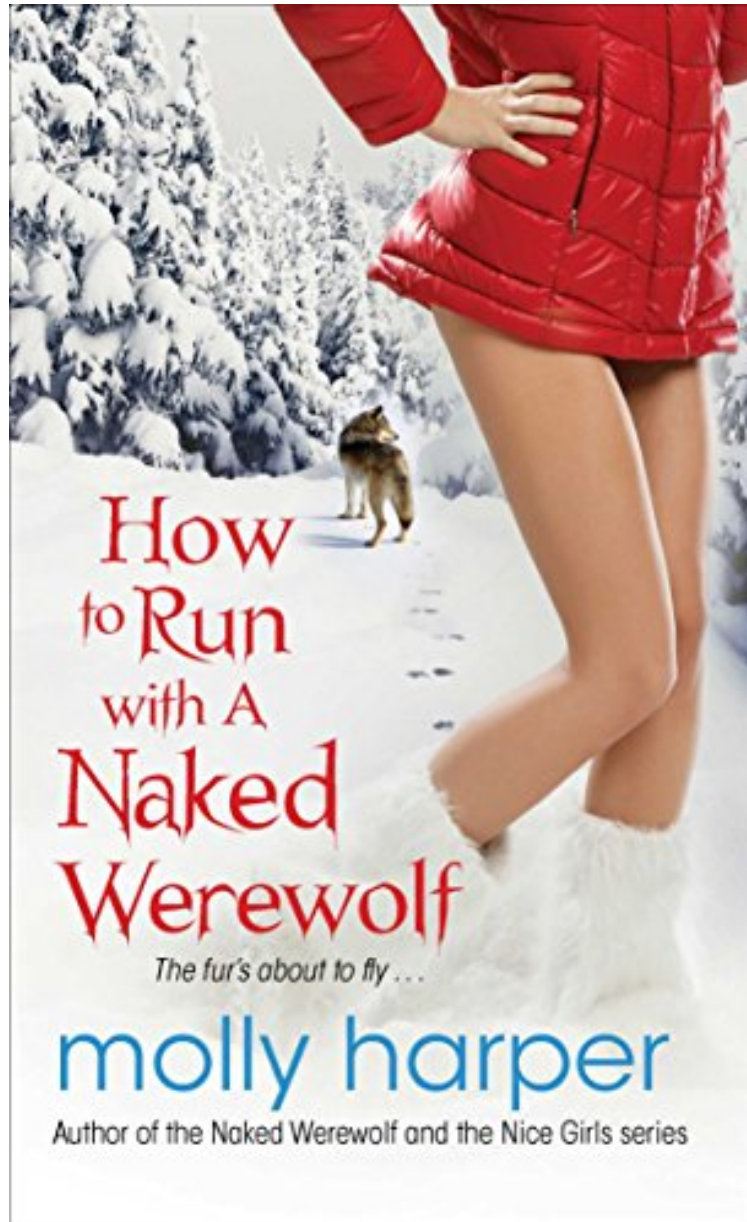

Review
If you have already read one or both of the "Naked Werewolf"-books, you know the Alaskan Werewolves that live near the small town of Grundy. And you know Anna, their human doctor. This is her story [since each book is about another member of or close to the pack, you needn't have read the previous ones. Although they're pretty good.]. The book starts with her in a sh***y job in a grocery and although this is already kinda "downshifted" for a M.D., she even has to give up that, when she gets into a shooting between Werewolf/Bounty Hunter Caleb and one of his "clients". This is the beginning of a story like one of those classical 70ies and 80ies roadmovies: the two of them are jumbled together and each for a reason of his/her own, cannot leave the other. These premises were already pretty cool: each of them hides stuff from the other, they circle warily around each other and their banter is as cool to read, as are the adventures they experience on their way to their respective destination, the city of Anchorage. But the light banter, the action movie-feel did not really deflect from the fact that Anna is on the run from marital abuse, a nearly-ex-husband, who is hunting her across the continent, is on her heels. This is why the story is not as light for me, as the first book [haven't read the 2nd yet] was: Anna's background plays a huge role and guides most of her actions [as is believable in this situation]. The way her problems were resolved was on the one hand satisfying, on the other hand a bit anticlimactic. But that could be me. As in the other books, there are Werewolves [and obviously other Werereatures, as they are mentioned], but there is not a real elaborated world-building explaining stuff. The Weres just... are. For a PNR, Anna's thoughts in her 1st person POV are pretty ample, she so does not just drool over some guy, but about how and whom to trust [and how far], where to go to, how to get new legal documents etc. I liked that, since the story delivers more than just romance, even if Caleb stayed a bit on the rather common "Werewolf must protect woman!"-side. But as a love interest, he was likable enough. It took me only one and a half days to finish the book, that's how interesting and enjoyable it is written.
