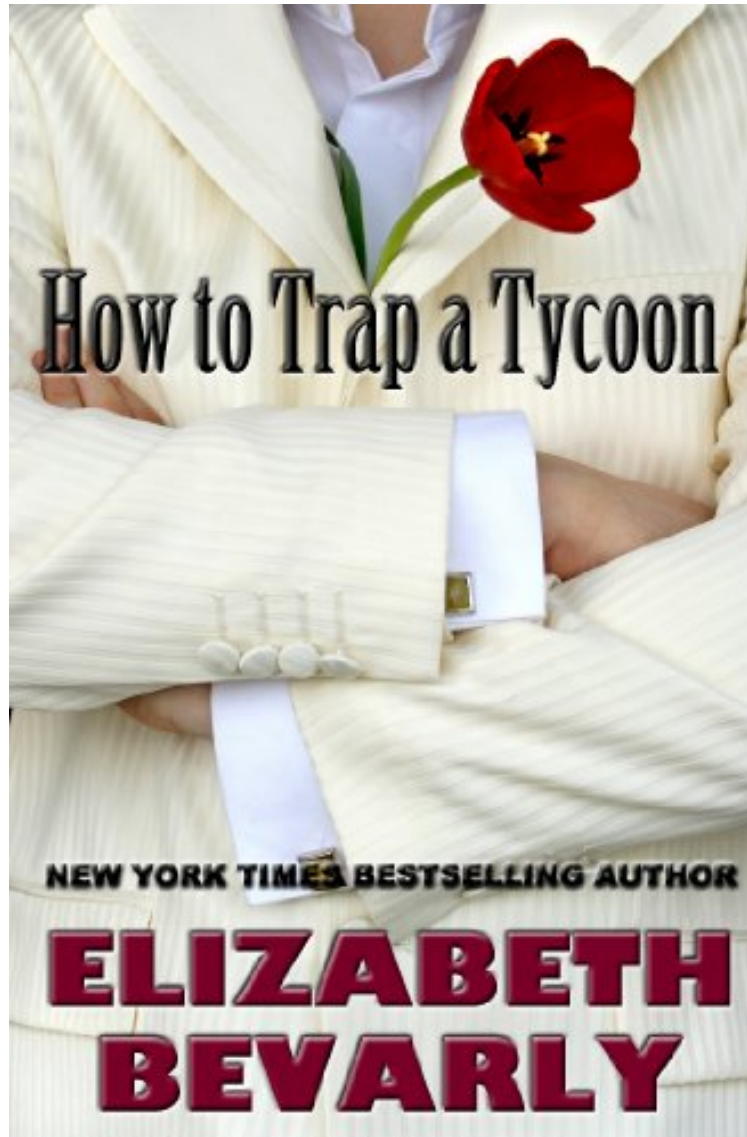

It starts out as a comedy but also has an element of melodrama in it.By day, Doresey MacGuinness is a sociology teaching assistant at a local college. She is also the author of a best selling guide on how to trap a tycoon that is the rave among women. Dorsey wrote the book under an assume name based on her mother's past experiences and to provide her mother with some retirement.
