Shanti's quest continues entertaining sequel in the Warrior Chronicles -series Von MinaNote: this is the second book of a fantasy series in which all installments contribute to an overall story arc. Therefore the books should be read in the right order and this is not a good place to start, obviously. If you're new to the Warrior Chronicles, I recommend to stop reading here and start with Chosen. ReviewHunted starts right where Chosen left off: Shanti has left the company of Cayan and the people of his town to lead the evil overlord Xandre away from him and his newly discovered power and to continue her quest as the Chosen and unite her surviving people with the inhabitants of the Shadow Lands. On her journey to the sea, Shanti hears of a new Chosen that has come forth one protected by Xandre and therefore his instrument. Shanti knows that she cannot let this other alleged Chosen succeed, for there wouldn't be any means then to stop Xandre from dominating the whole known world. But Shanti knows that she needs backup to do so and after being able to free her brother Rhonan and the enigmatic and gifted Burson from the Graygual, she rides back to Cayan to ask for his help on that quest. Well, the whole thing is made a wee bit more complicated by the ambitious and ruthless Graygual Hunter being on their heels. So this is a very pure form of hero's journey and not just Shanti's. We get her POV, but Cayan's as well even the elusive Hunter's at times. And although I sometimes found the POVs a bit random, they did a lot to enhance the scope of the story and give insight in other characters. That makes them better fleshed-out. Overall I liked the return of the already known characters, especially hilarious guys like Sanders and the introduction of Rhonan and Burson. Burson acts a bit like the hero's [or heroine's] guide on the journey, him being able to provide knowledge of the quest as such and more mundane, helping with finding the very literal right way to the Shadow Lands. The relationship between Cayan and Shanti stays complicated. They both have their respective troubles and issues and aren't likely to trust easily. In Shanti's case, she also still is afraid of losing loved ones, so she takes care not to love too deeply. And the good thing is: none of the obstacles preventing Cayan and Shanti from being the instant dream-couple feel in any way contrived. Besides, I appreciate it that the problems and tasks at hand always take precedence over lust or delving on deeper feelings. It's the characters more than anything else that make this such an enjoyable fantasy I like the overall story arc, the looming villain's threat of world-domination and the rebel's fight against the odds, the prophecies and the rest of the world building. But it's Shanti and her companions that keep me hooked.
