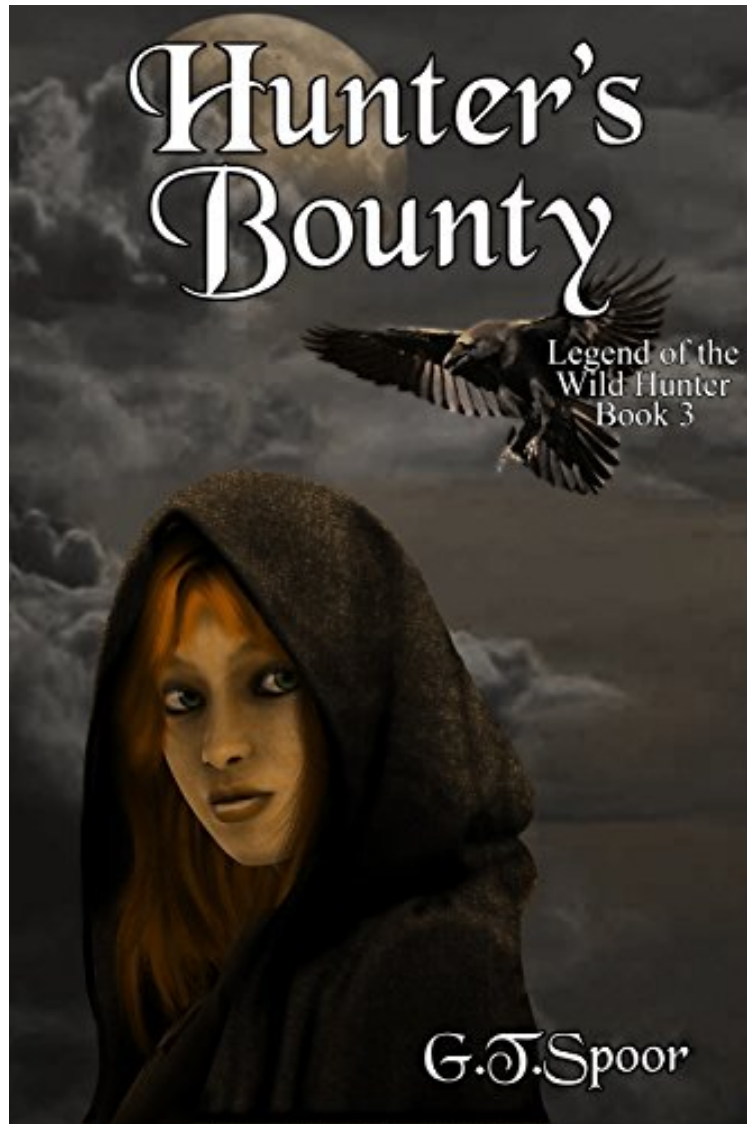

So I recommend to read the books in the intended order and start with Hunters Beginning. Review I loved this series from the start, flaws and all, it hit its mark with me: the young girl Kile Veller starting to train as a hunter against all odds and so many obstacles and just plain mean people was exactly my kind of protagonist. Added to that the nicely done world building, the cool magic concept of the mystic arts and Kile's super-special-snowflake kind of magic just added up to a series I just have to love. But with Hunters Bounty things got even more entertaining: the plot is even more gripping and Kile as a character is really interesting. She is not just the young woman growing into a heroine, no you don't exactly know what she is turning into or if this is good or rather scary and the last third or so of the book, I was glued to the pages to just get to know what would happen to her. The book starts with Kile being a level five hunter in Coopervill, the small town she was assigned to. But since there are more and more Hunters disappearing or being plainly killed, the kind of jobs Kile could do, are put on hold. That makes her bored and leaves her penniless. But don't fret, this doesn't keep up long, actually, poor Kile is dragged into some Machiavellian machinations pretty fast and they leave her framed for murder and a lot of other crimes and turn the Hunter into the hunted. And I have to tell you that Kile excels. She is resourceful, her being always on the run, trying to find the true culprit of the crimes, trying to unravel the much greater conspiracy behind it all, it was a blast. I suffered and virtually ran with her. And her Edge gets more interesting by the minute. Again, it's not as if the book is flawless, it's not. The missing proofreading really gets on my nerves with all the wrong words, misspellings, wrong tenses, you name it. And even concerning plot and characters, I was once or twice wondering why some rather important information wasn't passed on at the earliest moment and so on. But none of that did really anything to diminish my love for this book. The overall story arc is not finished [there are some more books coming], but there are answers to some open questions, Kile's character changes in believable and cool ways and there is no real cliffhanger at the end. So yes, this [and some editing] is all I want in a fantasy book.
