Einstieg in die Sazi-Serie - 3.5 PunkteVon Geisha XTony Giodone hat als Auftragskiller schon einiges erlebt, doch als er von Sue angeheuert wird, sie selbst zu ermorden, findet er sich in einer vllig neuen Situation wieder. Umso mehr als zwischen den beiden eine geradzu magnetische Anziehungskraft zugange ist. Und als dann Tony's Versuch der Geldwsche fehlschlgt, ihm ein Feind im Nacken sitzt und Sue's Familie sich querstellt, berschlagen sich die Ereignisse. Und zu alledem ist auch noch Vollmond und Tony ein Werwolf. Aber wer wird sich schon von solchen Kleinigkeiten aufhalten lassen.Das Autorenteam Clamp Adams hat hier mit dem ersten Band der Sazi-Serie um Gestaltwandler, bzw. in diesem Fall Werwlfe, eine interessante Welt geschaffen. An einigen Stellen ist dies zwar berzeichnet, so zum Beispiel nimmt Tony Gefhle als Dfte wahr, was aber berhand nimmt und die Schmerzgrenze des Ertrglichen bersteigt wenn er alle zwei Abstze den Citrusgeruch des Glcks, den Geruch nach heissem Metall der Entschlossenheit, den Geruch nach verbranntem Kaffee, der Wut bedeutet. Zwar finde ich die Idee, dass Werwlfe Gefhle riechen knnen, gut, doch hier bekam dieses Konzept durch die andauernde Erwhnung und die stndigen Vergleiche einen billigen und unglaubwrigen Charakter.Umso besser gelungen ist den Autoren die Hauptperson des Ich-Erzhlrs Tony. Endlich ein Held, der keine Probleme damit hat ein "bser Junge" zu sein. Tony ist ein Autragskiller, das ist nun mal sein Job und damit basta! Schlaflose Nchte hat er deswegen nicht. Schade, dass das Buch hier zu sehr auf die Liebesgeschichte ausgelegt war und wir Tony kaum in Aktion als Killer erleben durften - davon htte ich mir reichlich mehr gewnscht.Weniger berzeugt war ich von der Figur der Heldin Sue, die mich ein wenig genervt hat, wenn allerdings auch nicht so sehr wie manche andere Heldin in anderen paranormalen Serien.Auch war das Ende leider durch eine berdosis literarischen Zuckerguss ins Kitschige abgerutscht.
