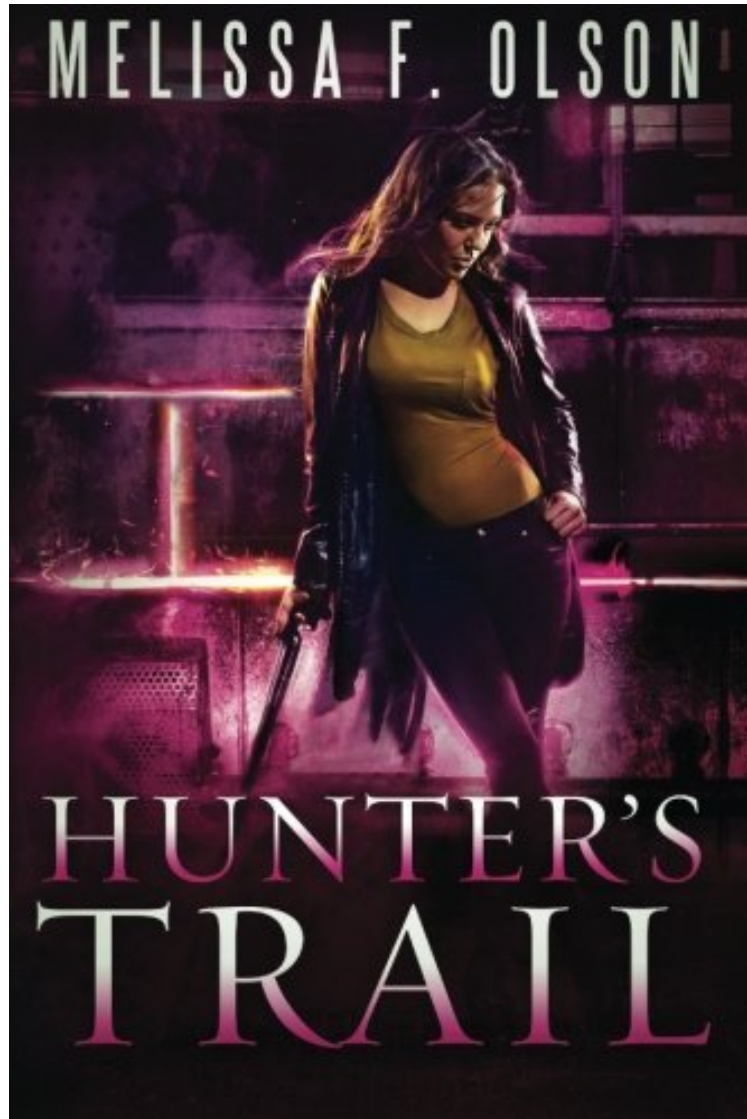

Anyway, there will be spoilers for events in prior books. Review Thank goodness, with this book the series managed to finally make me a fan. Not of the world building or the various plots with crime, riddles and blood and gore, these I liked from the start. But here, in Hunter's Trail, Scarlett starts acting like a grown up person, owns her decisions and more important, she makes them herself. There is no whining, no self-consciousness and no behaving like a teenager or everybody's pawn. Although Scarlett has it rough in Hunter's Trail. There are bodies that are dumped on Will, the LA Alpha's, doorstep and this is even worse than it sounds, because it was Scarlett's turning Eli human again in the last book that destabilized the pack. So things are tense: Will has some murderous foreign werewolf in his territory and a mutiny brewing in his pack. Because the supernaturals in LA have their very own cleaner of all messes, it's Scarlett and a reluctant Cop Jesse Cruz to work on the murder case, trying to stop it for good. This alone is hard, but it's getting worse. A hunter is on the killer's heels and here the cure seems to be worse than the illness. At least for werewolves. And while Scarlett and Jesse are at it, they sure can take care of that, too. This would be a hard job at the best of times, but Scarlett isn't at her best. Her knee is still injured and she doesn't have time or money to have it properly taken care of. Jesse has a lot of righteous moments and reminds me a lot of the cop Elemental Assassin Gin Blanco kind of dated for a time. If you know the series, you know what I'm talking about: this guy being attracted to the protagonist, but detesting what she does and continually criticizing her and overall acting erratic. Not good. Jesse is a huge letdown character-wise. But he isn't the only one. Suffice it to say that Scarlett is let down a lot. But on the sunny side is this probably why she shows such huge personality development. And I'm a great fan of how she plays it with her supernatural bosses, Jesse, Eli and everything else. Oh and if you were wondering: the abominable love triangle gets resolved. Now she is one of those UF heroines I really can admire: making mistakes, but knowing who she is and where her boundaries are.
