Stupid humansVon PyoroWe all know how the story of the reclusive, theoretically-attractive-but-"too-tomboyish" heroine goes: after no more than 2 or 3 books she runs around in dresses, gets fawned over by a prince, and learns to eat with

the right fork. Thank Jue then that this series doesn't care too much for tropes. Kile, the heroine, isn't too fond of humans: they're noisy, don't smell nice, have stupid rules, and wage pointless wars. Hard to deny. Instead of becoming more "socially acceptable", she's becoming less so. In that regard, this series reminds me a lot of the Firekeeper Saga, which also had a protagonist who much rather hung out with wolves than anyone else. The plot is fairly interesting, with some great highlights. It's also quite a decent length. There's some aspects I found lacking though, and the sudden onslaught of tiny but perhaps not entirely insignificant romantic subplots is really at odds with everything else (I'm particularly suspicious about the King, isn't he like 20 years older than she is?). There's also the "usual" problems of self-published novels; lack of proofreading, so some errors got missed, and lack of editing, which means some scenes and dialogues aren't perhaps quite as nice to read as they should be. By and large though still better than comparable novels, I'd say. Altogether a fun novel, especially if you don't have too high an opinion of humanity. Which, you know, with 2016 just behind us, should apply to a broad spectrum of readers. Just saying. I just wish the next (final?) book would come around one of these days.
