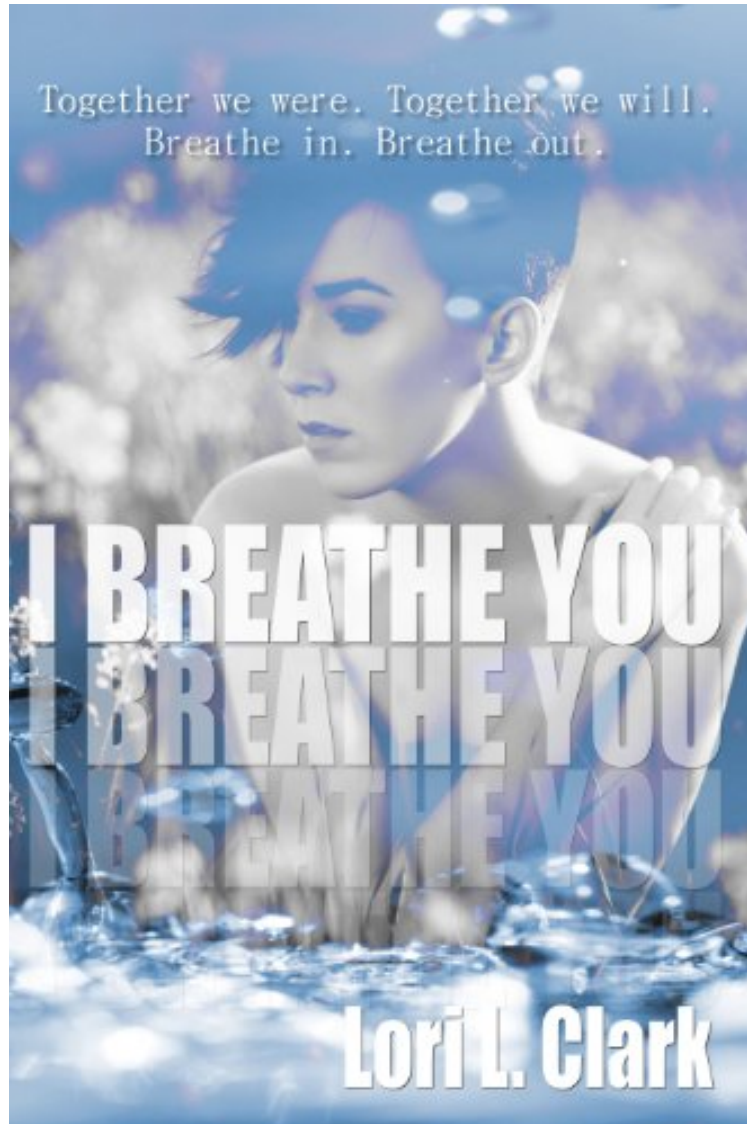

This could have been a great book if I hadn't been so annoyed by the female lead. It started out like a rock star romance and I was a bit surprised because I didn't expect that

at all. But the setting quickly changes to a quiet country town where the story unfolds. Rhane is broken (well, no surprise there considering the current trend contemporary romances). After a bad car accident, her whole life shattered in tiny pieces. She has to give up her life as lead singer of a rock band. In the accident, she has lost her voice and the love of her life, Dalton. With the help of her grandma's heritage, she moves far away from her past to start a new life. Ian Callahan is the constructor who helps her remodel the old house to her wishes. And, of course, he is sexy as hell. His life hasn't been easy either, he's 24 and the father of a 7-year-old, deaf daughter. One could say that both aren't ready to commit to anything permanent. But life doesn't always ask whether you're ready, right? Love just takes what it needs. So why didn't I like Rhane? I was already a bit irritated about her behavior as a rock star. She definitely had anger management issues and was behaving irritatingly immature. The book lacks Ian's perspective so it was really hard to believe that he finds her attractive. I couldn't stand her attitude at all. She just kept pushing everyone away because life was so mean to her. But to me, it just sounded like constant whining.
