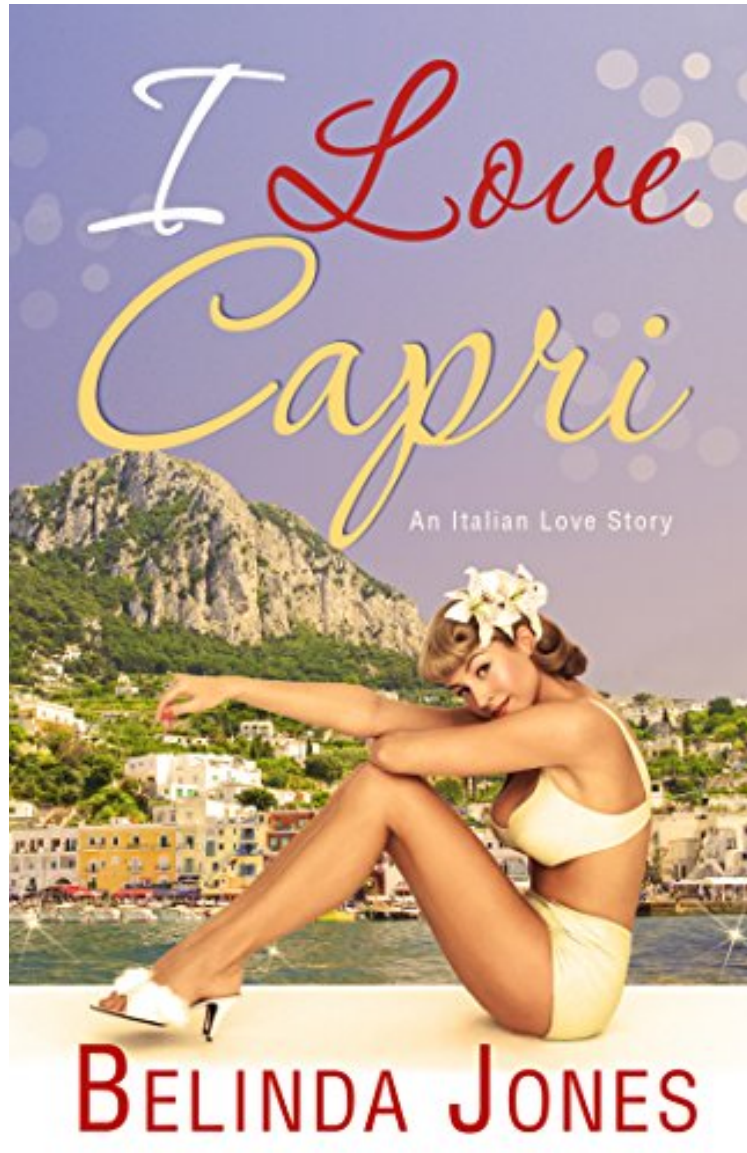

The forth novel of Belinda Jones is written in her typical style. It is easy to read and perfect for some relaxing moments. But it also animates to think about life and relationships. When I finished the novel I was really surprised with the end. Avoiding giving away the end right now, I just can say this book describes life how it is for most women. But it is interesting to follow the protagonist through several stages of her personal development.  
This time Kim, a professional translator, met her mother at Capri. Her mother was used to live there until she was twelve. As her grandmother found out about the other woman in her grandfathers' life, they moved to Cardiff.  
Now, about 40 years later, her grandfather was died and left a shop. Somebody has to run this business. Until now gorgeous Luca did this job. As Kim saw him, it was love at first sight.
