I was missing Da Romance but its all there, just not following the usual path. Its all in Nashs head, so to speak, by introspective and coming to terms with what has

really happened it wasn't just a pleasant shag during a one week course, nor was it a mere male bonding thing going on between him and down-to-earth rural copper Glen. They connected on more than one level, and yet there's no talk of a possible future together. Well, there is, but it's only half-hearted ideas being flung about. Nash's not ready to give up his shiny career, and Glen's firmly rooted to his home soil. So they part, and both are miserable about it. Then Glen goes missing, goes missing right after dropping Nash off at the airport, and Nash rushes right back, ready to move heaven and earth to find Glen, and it's then that he realizes how silly their previous reasoning really was: Nash cared enough for Glen to drop everything, even risk his precious, all-important Job to race across the country when he'd thought Glen might be dead. And yet, the idea of doing the same thing when Glen was alive and well and could reciprocate had seemed impossible then, even crazy. Crazy to try to find a way to make it work with the man he loved? So, yeah, I'm glad I picked this one up once more, too, because I really really liked it on the second read. Of course now that I've discovered the hidden beauty of the Nash + Glen story, I'd like to read more. How will they make this work?
