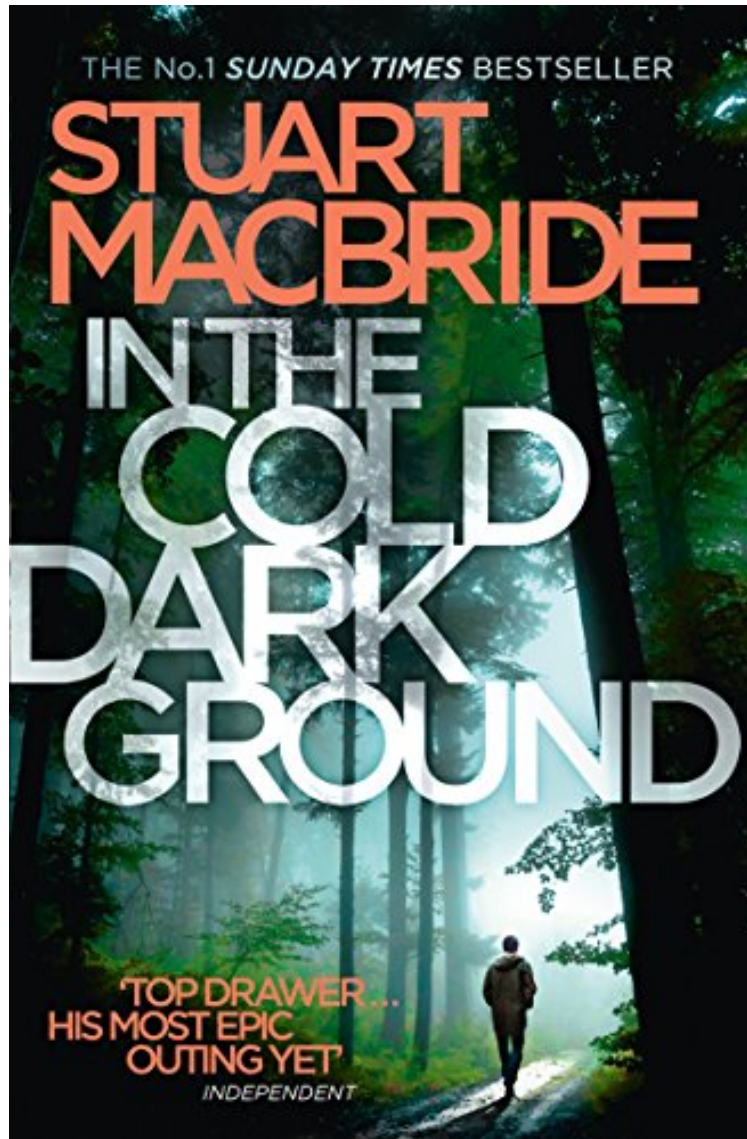

This is a real thriller, where death looms in every angle - and most of the dying has to do very personally with Logan aka "Laz" McRae. For his much beloved girlfriend Samantha has now reached the end of the line - the doctors are keeping her on life-maintaining machines for 5 long years. And now the time has come to let her go, they say. And Logan - who sees her and speaks with her day and night in his time free from police work - knows that, too. Because slowly but surely he is going insane... An other old friend of Logan has reached the end of his life - Wee Hamish Mowat, head of Aberdeen's criminal underworld, is dying, too. Of cancer. And right behind him in the shades Reuben the Beast is only waiting for his last breath to take over the reign. Which may be a reign of terror and gang-wars, because the rival gangs from all over the UK are enviously looking at his territory. But Logan has a big problem with all that - because Wee Hamish has chosen HIM for the execution of his will. And that doesn't fit well for Reuben, his declared enemy. Who wants his head now - and on the spot! And with him have to die his nearest and dearest - this "family" he has strangely formed with Detective Chief Inspector Steel and her wife Susan, and the 2 small daughters whose Daddy he is. In a way... And now his missing-persons investigation has just turned up a body in the woods - battered to death and a bin bag duct-taped over its head. As this is the MO of the Aberdeen Gangster Malk the Knife, a Major Investigation Team charges up to Banff. And DCI Roberta Steel is once again leading the game - like in the good old times, as she puts it for Laz... But it's not enough trouble: the new Superintendent Niahm Harper is on her way up from the Serious Organised Crime Task Force, too. And starts without obvious motives to make Logan's life miserable. And last but not least: The Ginger-haired Ninja aka SI Napier from Professional Standards is poking around and wants Logan to spy on DCI Steel. She seemingly has fixed up a very violent but very sly woman-batterer and -molester and child-abuser. Who is now whining in his high-protection prison cell about his fate - being for once on the receiving end of the abuses... All this is a bit too much for Sergeant Logan McRae. When he decides to free Samantha from her earthly burdens on a Friday the 13th, Wee Hamish too has left this world. So now there are funerals to organize and to go, lives to defend, police work to be done, DCI Steel to keep under control and a lot of other stuff, mostly connected to violence - punches, knives, shots and blood, sweat and tears. And most of it under the critical and unforgiving eyes of all his superiors. Who are a whole bunch in these days. And Logan has to stay on the right side of the law or his yet poor situation in the Scottish Police Forces is in danger. But even more in danger is his life - permanently. Because Reuben wants him out of the way - permanently. This thriller is so full of death and violence that threaten Logan McRae that the investigation of the MisPers case becomes somehow secondary. The crimes are very well constructed and the reading is very fluent because of the twists and turns that surprise the reader in almost every chapter.
