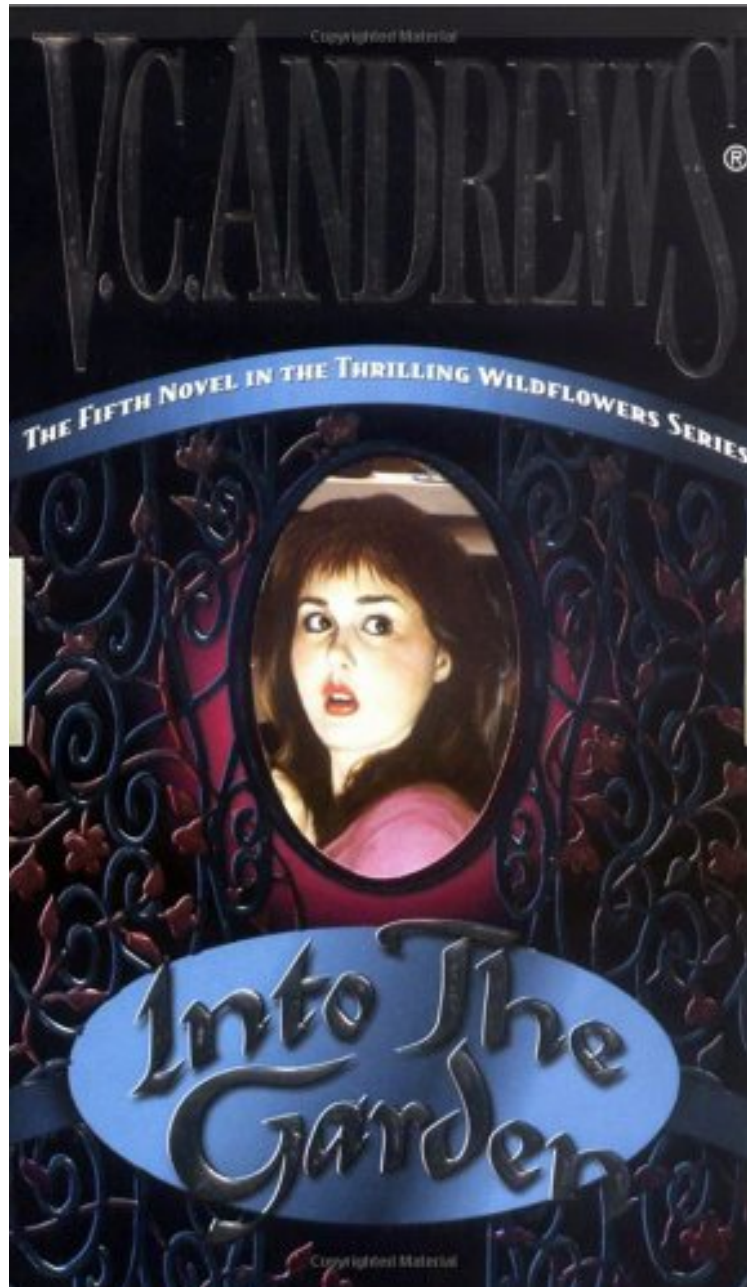

McDonaldI recently read the book, "Into the Garden" (pub. 1999) by V.C. Andrews. The book was about a group of four friends who call themselves "the orphans with parents" or OWP's for short. In the beginning, the main character's (Cat) mother dies. After she dies, the four girls take over her house and turn it into their headquarters. This book reminds me a lot of another book by V.C. Andrews called "Runaways" (pub. 1997) which was also about four friends. One difference is that in "Runaways" the girls were really orphans, and in "Into the Garden" the girls had parents, and called themselves orphans. The main character, Cat, is very interesting. She is kind of paranoid about everything the girls do. The rest of the girls try to get her to loosen up. They pretty much redo the whole house that they have taken over for their "headquarters". Then they all take turns staying the night there with Cat, where they plot some pretty deceitful things. This story was a very good story about some mischievous young girls, and it was very interesting and held my attention all the way through.
