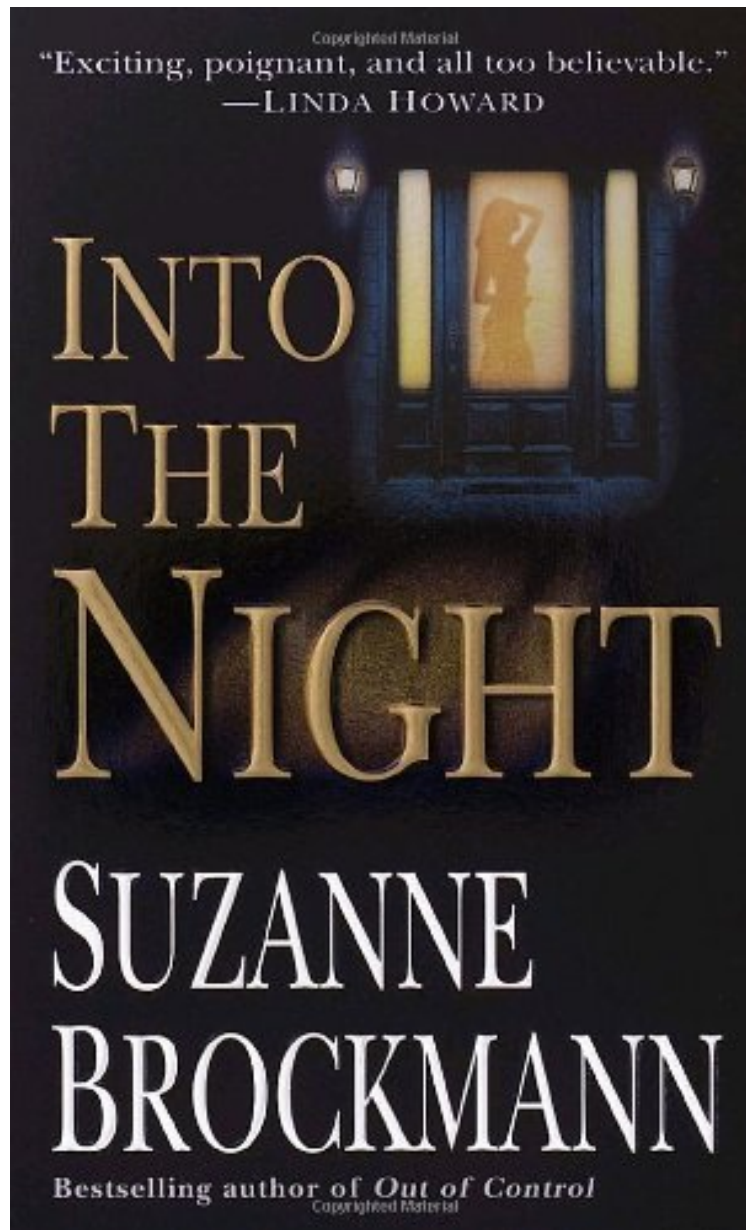

'Gone too far' gelesen und beschlossen, dass sie einfach eine "bitch" ist. Ich war berrascht, wie sehr mich die Geschichte gefesselt hat. Die Geschichte von Mike Muldoon und Joan hat mich ebenfalls sehr berhrt, obwohl ich Joan manchmal htte schtteln mgen. Die Geschichte von Joans Groeltern, die an Ereignisse aus dem 2. Weltkrieg anknpt, ist ebenfalls sehr einflussam erzht. Hier gibt es nicht so viel action, dafr aber eine sehr schne Liebesgeschichte. Es ist manchmal recht schwierig mehrere Handlungsstrnge so zu verweben, dass kein Bruch entsteht. Dies ist Suzanne Brockmann hier gelungen. A bit different Von Ein Kunde Now this is the story of cute, little Lt., Junior Grade, Michael Muldoon, the really nice guy known from the last two books in the series. Mike has to deal with a knee injury and being liaison officer to White House staff member Joan scouting the location for a presidential visit. Both are immediately attracted to each other, but Joan can't quite take him seriously because Mike is seven years younger. While these two characters squabble and fight or act on their attraction, another focus lies on Mary Lou Starret and her increasingly unhappy life. This avenue is sometimes a little overexplored for my taste, but probably necessary for the next book. I would have liked to read more about Stan and Teri from Over the Edge, which would have been logical as Stan and Mike were described as good friends, but this doesn't happen. However, this still is a great and hilarious book and definitely a great read even if the pace is somewhat different from the other books.
