The pace of the story is maintained through the use of the POV of the main characters. Each takes turns to have their say. I found this way of presenting the story easy to follow and thought it helped character development. My favourite POV was Hershey the dog. He helps provide some lighter moments, and it made me smile that the author seems to know the inner workings of a dog's brain so well! This book made me feel so many emotions.
