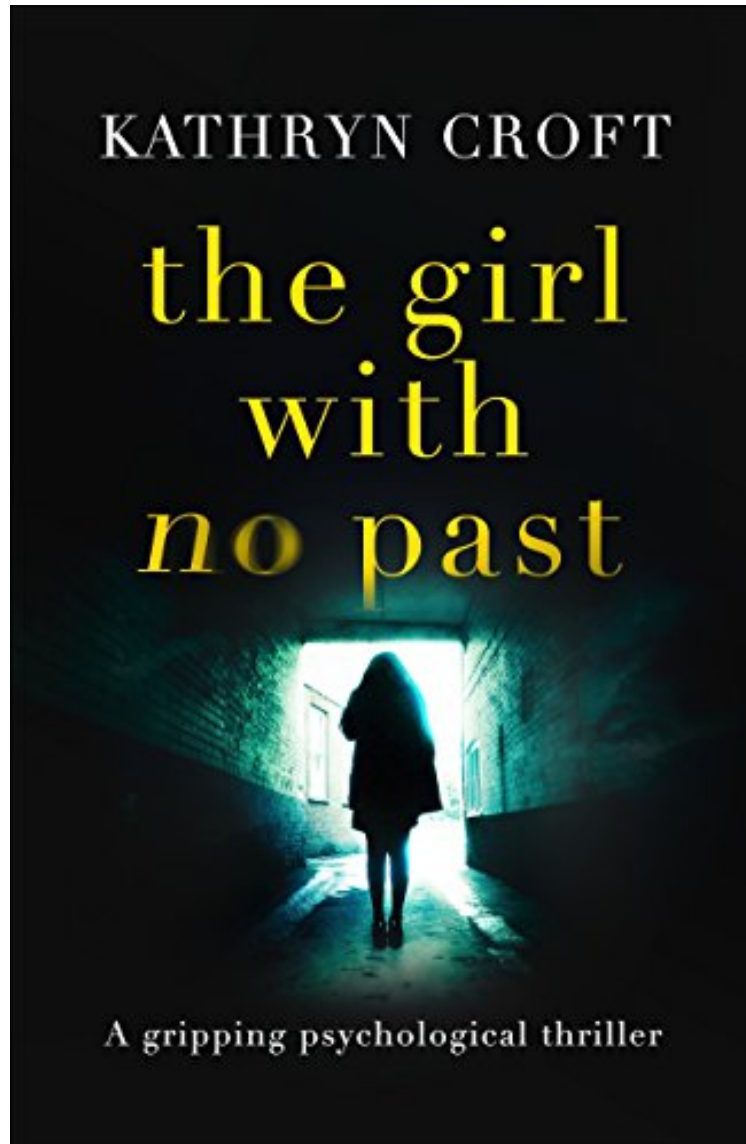

Hard to put down, but didn't quite hold together believably Von amanda Adam's character needed more fleshing out as to why he behaved as he did. Leah's self-blame seemed overdone and I didn't feel she was given sufficient vindication as her only mistake was to be drawn in by Adam's "charisma" and was strongly against his vendetta against Miss Hollis, even physically trying to stop him when he attacked her. I felt a need, after all the grimness and suffering, for an epilogue with Leah fully vindicated, perhaps reunited with Julian once he understood the true story. Better still I would have liked Julian to have had a change of heart, choosing not to believe the words of a stranger and instead believing in his own feelings about Leah (whose character was very appealing and suffering from a mistaken belief about the extent of her culpability). I found it particularly hard to believe that all the people involved chose to believe Leah guilty of a heinous crime without any evidence or asking for her side of the story.
