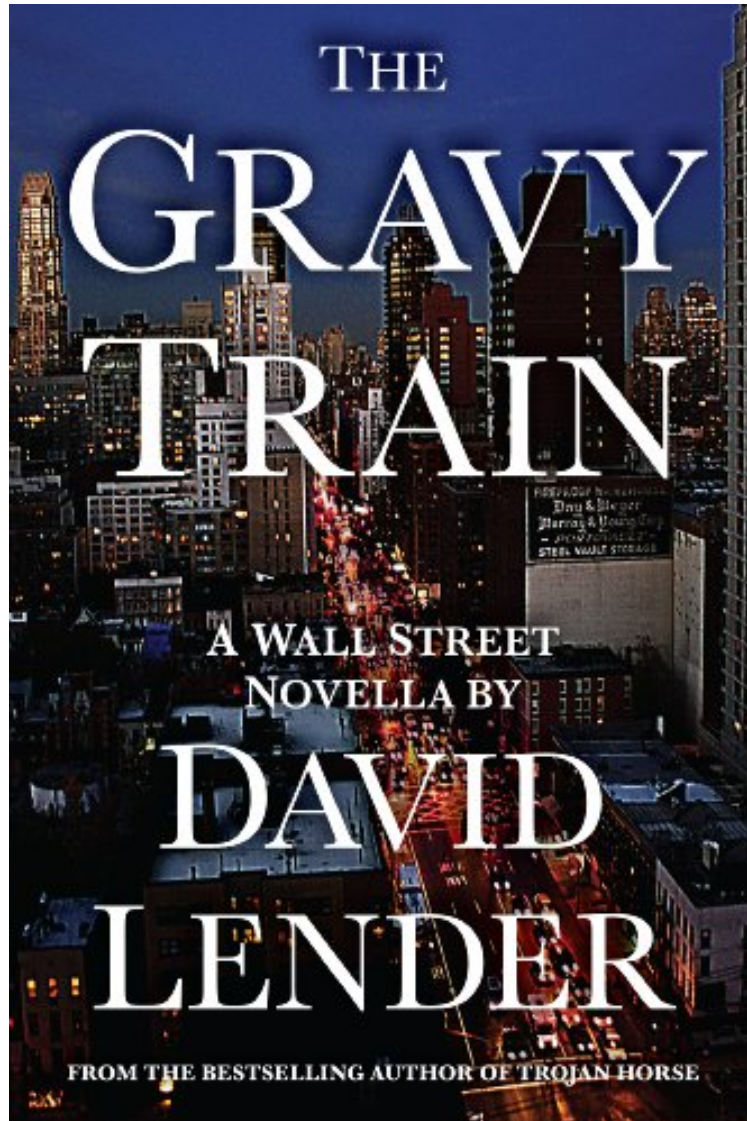

The story is okay, some highlights are, perhaps, a bit overdone. Again, if high-level finance is of interest, I would recommend the story.
