Makenna Fraser is a newbie at the SPI, Supernatural Protection and Investigation in NYC. She is a Seer, a very rare kind of human who's able to see through any veil or glamour any supernatural could wear to hide form the human population. Most supernaturals are very law-abiding werewolves, vampires, fae or what else the UF reader can think of, but if they are not, the SPI gets involved. Mak is the typical rookie, making a great lot of mistakes, still learning the trade and sulking, because her partner Ian won't let her have a real gun, before she proves she won't shoot herself or others accidentally. But when some supernaturals get murdered splatter-like and Mak seems to be connected to it all [and: taaaa, has abilities that make a difference], the whole NYC SPI is suddenly in an uproar. And just when I thought, I knew what this book and the series were like, the hunt for the culprit starts in earnest and it very strongly reminded me of some Aliens scenes, with the team being searching for the literal monster in some claustrophobic surrounding, you as a reader bite your nails, because just like the team you don't know what's behind the next corner and you fear that the hunters really could be the hunted. But what I liked was that the lightness that is Makenna Fraser makes for a fair balance, so the story never gets too dark or lets the suspense become unbearable. But then, this is what I already knew of the author from her Raine Benares series: dark and dire moments are counterbalanced by upbeat and snarky comments and reprieves. What else I appreciated was the very intricate case they were on. They really are investigating, but the boring part of such procedural work is completely missing. Yet, the case and the SPI's work feel real [even when a host of mythical creatures appears] and each and every finding makes the whole picture more stunning. The case is somewhat solved so one can't call it a cliffhanger by any means, but there is follow up work to do and Mak, Ian and the rest of them have their work in the next book cut out for them. The story is truly entertaining and if the series continues like that, I'm a total fan.
