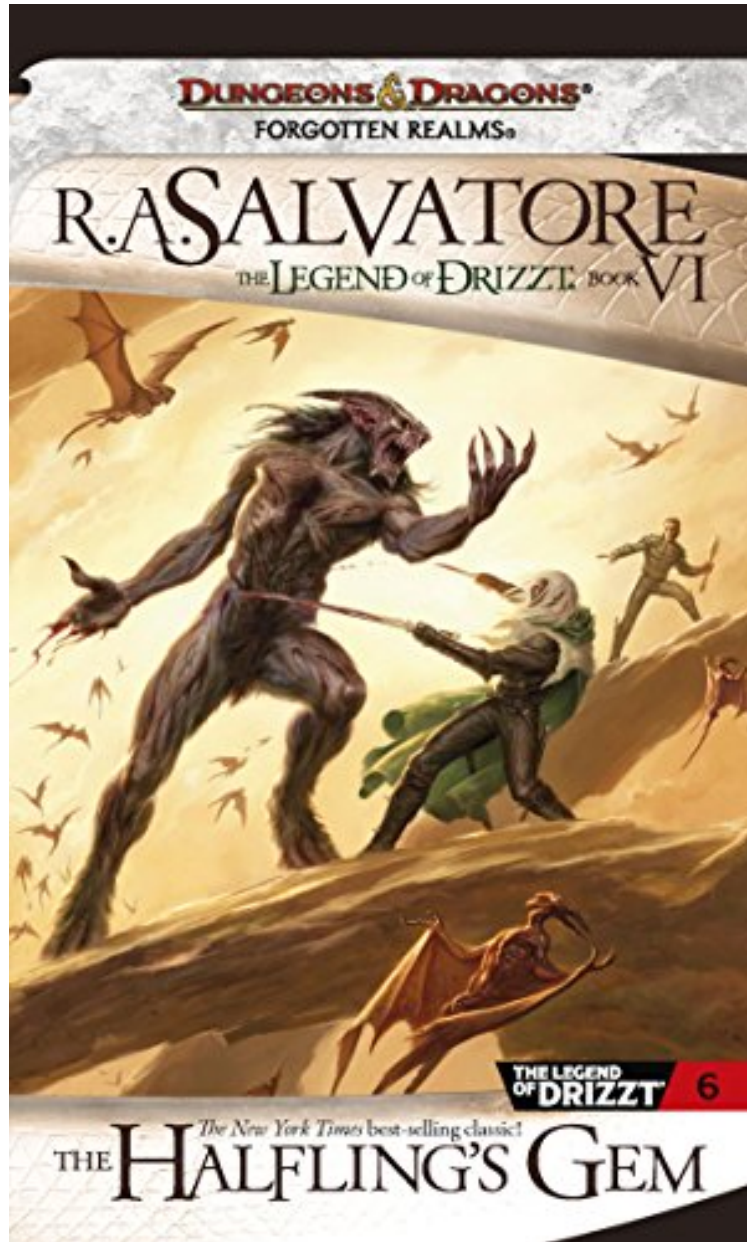

enttäuschender Abschluss Von Drizzt Do'Urden Nach "Streams of Silver" gestaltet R. A. Salvatore den Abschluss seines Heldenepos eher enttäuschend: die Handlung ist uerst linear aufgebaut und fast immer vorhersehbar. Als unzertrennliche Gruppe meistern die Charaktere frher oder spter, meist durch Waffengewalt, jede Herausforderung. Diese Regelmigkeit drckt auf die Spannungskurve und wird nur an wenigen Stellen, wie zum Beispiel durch die Teleportation in die Schattenebene Tartarus, durchbrochen. Ein unangenehmes Novum in diesem Roman ist der Hang des Autors zu bertreibungen: die Gruppe besteht ohne Zweifel aus starken, geschickten und erfahrenen Kmpfern. Die Tatsache jedoch, da Wulfgar im Wstensand Kamele stemmt und anschlieend auf Gegner wirft oder gallopiierende Pferde durch reine Muskelkraft zum Stehen bringt, machen das Werk unglaublich. Wenn man von dem Dunkelelf und seinem Gegenspieler Artemis Entreri absieht, erscheinen auch die Hauptcharaktere clichhafter denn je: Bruenor Battlehammer ist als Zwerg gutherzig wenn auch mrrisch; Wulfgar ist als Barbar zwar einfltig aber krftig. Dadurch ist es kein Wunder, da der interessanteste der Charaktere, Drizzt Do'Urden, durch seine Einzigartigkeit nun deutlich dominiert. Obwohl die Handlung an vielen Stellen, genau wie bei den Vorgngerromanen, eher schwerflig von Statten geht, sind die Kampfszenen wohl durchdacht und mit viel Liebe zum Detail beschrieben. Als Fazit bleibt daher festzuhalten, da es sich bei "The Halfling's Gem" um den schlechtesten Roman der Icewind Dale Triologie handelt. His bad experiences in the Underdark have weighed on his character, and the story of him getting over them while rescuing his friend, fighting his near-equal in sword skill, chasing pirates...the characters are the best. If you don't like the characters and look for Grisham or Clancy-like plots in every book you read, then read Grisham or Clancy and evaluate R.A. Salvatore's work in the context of what he intended it to be. The plot is very simple, and kind of predictable, but the fact is that I supremely enjoyed the book despite this; it should have been a bestseller, and that Salvatore managed to create such a masterpiece with such a simple plot.
