It was for free, so what if grammatical tenses were wrong, words were

missing and some word orders made no sense at all? It was for free and I found the basic concept intriguing. The story itself was a bit too sweet and too much American kitsch, so what, it was for free. So I bought the first book of this space opera. The basics of the story are simple. A superior race of aliens appears on the doorstep of Earth and asks more or less politely to take with them a few thousand young men - or else! The reason behind this all is not really important and a little outlandish. To get to the bottom of the story: every young "Earthling" is to be mated to one of the aliens (all male) and to bear children for them. So when one of the aliens, starship commander Keyno kidnapped young human Dale to be his mate, no one argues. It's a space opera with a lot of interracial (and this doesn't mean skin color) gay sex. BUT! This story was not for free and the grammar and mistakes are even worse than in the free short story.
