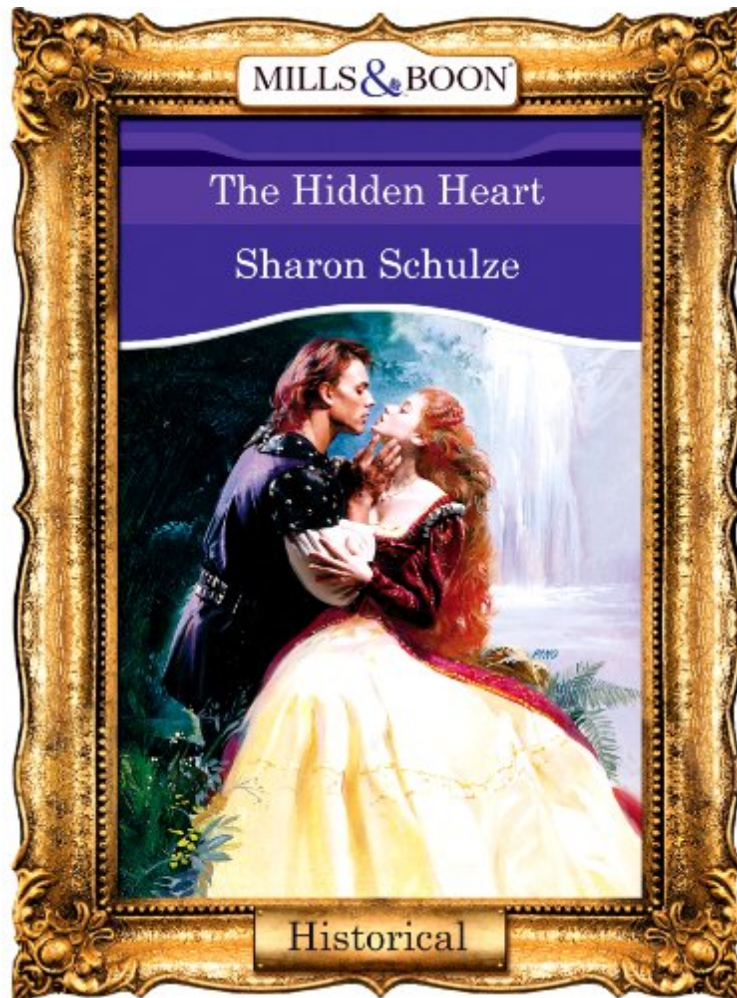

They haunted me, a situation that didn't end when I closed my notebook and hid them away in a drawer. Out of sight . . . but they were seldom out of my mind. Years later, when I joined my local Romance Writers of America chapter, I dragged that notebook out and leapt into their story again. I finished their book, entered it in contests, sent it to publishers. It didn't sell. Eventually, with great sadness, I turned my back on my first characters and moved on to another story. My other tales revolved around the Marcher keep of l'Eau Clair that I'd created for my two lovers, and I cast them in minor, supporting roles. I sold the third book, HEART OF THE DRAGON, to Harlequin Historicals, and then the second book. I gave the stories a name the l'Eau Clair Chronicles and wrote still another tale, THE SHIELDED HEART.
