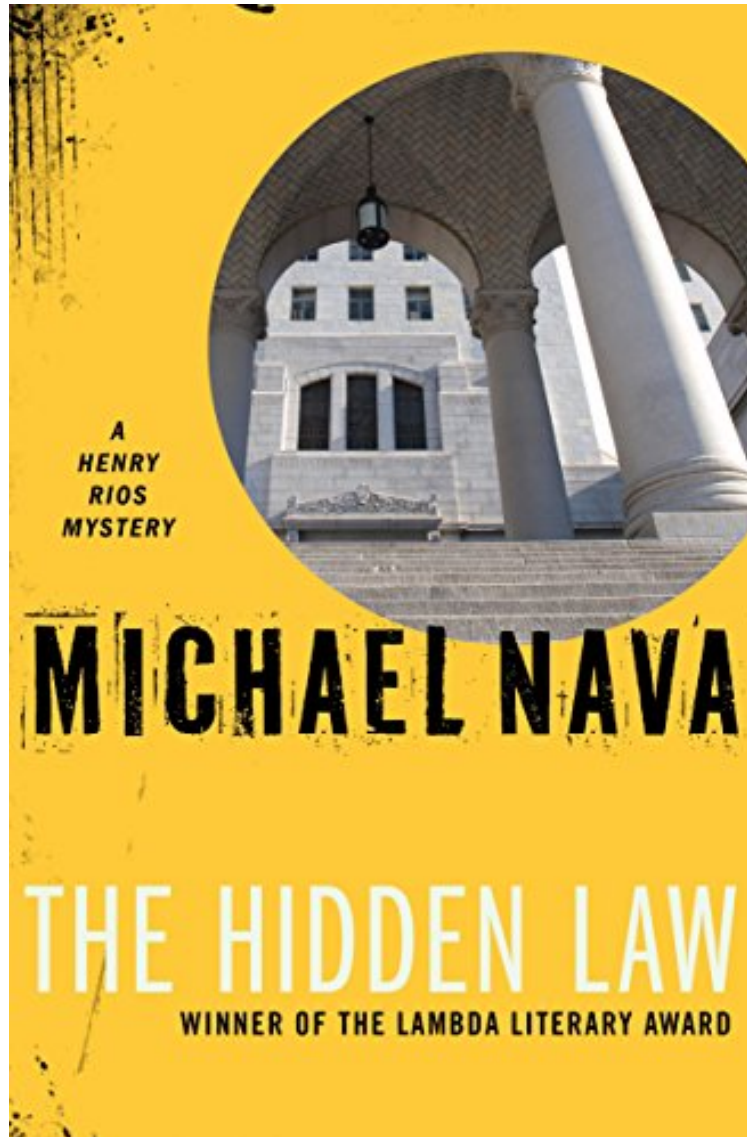

Not only by his appealing language that I (as a non-native speaker) think to be equally demanding and lively and not too much laded with legal terms. But above all by his ability to tell complex

stories in small books. At first glance the book is about a crime. Henry Rios is a gay lawyer who defends a young boy suspected of having shot a politician in Los Angeles. But additionally the reader is also introduced in the world of gay men at the beginning of the nineties when AIDS represented a deadly menace to the homosexual community, and the prejudices and the hostility of the heterosexual Society became openly evident. The leading Motive of this story, alcoholism and its devastating effects on families, is sensitively but nonetheless precisely developed. As Rios tries to build the case for a different killer, he descends into the dark underbelly of Los Angelesa hotbed of vice and corruption.
