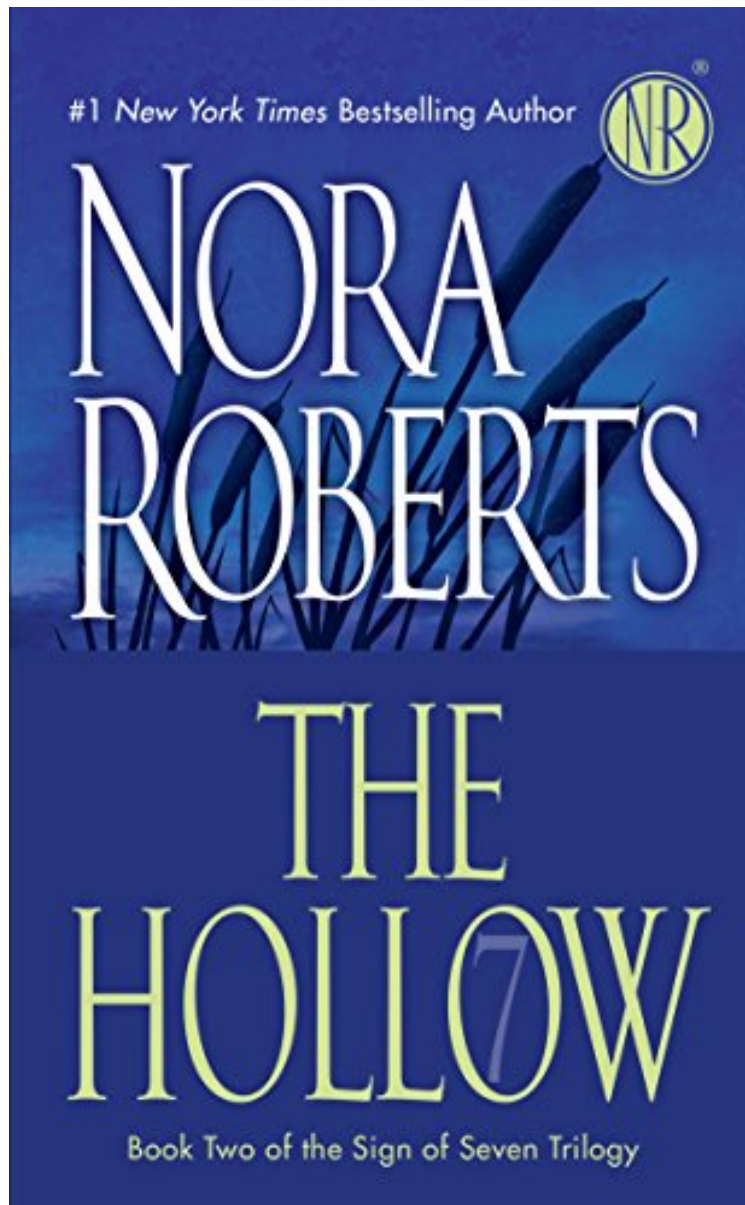

Trilogy", this book returns to Hawkins Hollow and it's cyclical demon to follow the storyline of Fox O'Dell and Layla. Since that day at The Pagan Stone, he has been able to see into other peoples minds, a talent he shares with Layla. The Seven draws nearer and the three men and their female counterparts inch their way closer to stopping the evil force that corrupts the otherwise picturesque village for seven days every seven years. They dig deeper into the history of the demon and the guardian -and into their own history. The plot is generally as a reader would expect for the middle installment: carrying forth, nothing groundbreaking, steady action towards a partially conclusive ending. Background is given to the series in the beginning of the novel, but in the interest of advancing the book the background doesn't seem as informative as it should be. Die Liebesgeschichte zwischen Fox und Layla kann nicht wirklich fesseln und berhrte mich nicht sonderlich. Die Geschichte selbst weist eine Anzahl logischer Brche auf, die wohl auch darin begrndet liegen, dass Roberts sich nicht traut, ihren Helden menschliche Schwchen zu lassen, was insbesondere in Fox Hintergrundgeschichte deutlich wird. Die "Lsung" dieser Episode kommt pltzlich und unbegrndet. Warum die Hauptpersonen so genau wissen, was zu tun ist, bleibt das Geheimnis der Autorin, das sie anscheinend nicht mit ihren Lesern teilen mchte. Ein paar gute Szenen sind sicher vorhanden, aber ich kann den Kauf dieses Buches nur hartgesottenen Fans empfehlen und auch sie sollten sich auf eine gewisse Langeweile einstellen.
