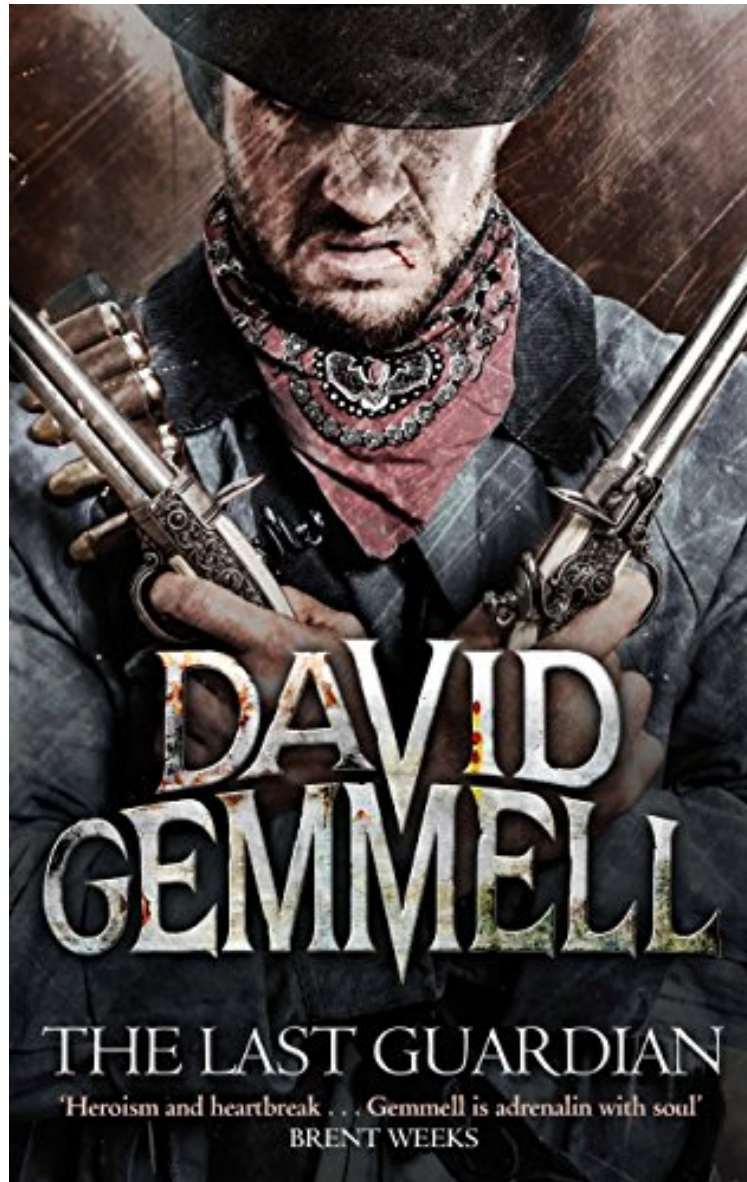

Manchmal habe ich das Gefühl (ohne gesteinigt werden zu wollen), dass die deutschen Übersetzer der Gemell-Werke echte Künstler sind, denn die deutschen Versionen vermitteln manchmal eine deutlich tiefere Atmosphäre als die englische Version bei Gemell.
